HOUSE BILL NO. 492

1 AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE ISSUANCE OF DISTINCTIVE MOTOR VEHICLE 2 LICENSE TAGS TO SUPPORTERS OF THE FORMER SAM M. BRINKLEY HIGH 3 SCHOOL IN JACKSON, MISSISSIPPI; TO PRESCRIBE AN ADDITIONAL FEE FOR 4 THE ISSUANCE OF SUCH LICENSE TAGS; TO PROVIDE FOR THE DISTRIBUTION 5 OF THE ADDITIONAL FEE COLLECTED FROM THE ISSUANCE OF SUCH LICENSE 6 TAGS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 8 SECTION 1. (1) Any owner of a motor vehicle who is a 9 resident of this state, upon payment of the road and bridge 10 privilege taxes, ad valorem taxes and registration fees as 11 prescribed by law for private carriers of passengers, pickup 12 trucks and other noncommercial motor vehicles, and upon payment of 13 an additional fee in the amount provided in subsection (3) of this section, shall be issued a distinctive license tag for any motor 14 15 vehicle registered in his name identifying such person as a supporter of the former Sam M. Brinkley High School in Jackson, 16 Mississippi. The distinctive license tags so issued shall be of 17 18 such color and design as the Department of Revenue, with the advice of the Brinkley High School Alumni Association, may 19

20 prescribe and shall consist of such letters or numbers, or both, 21 as may be necessary to distinguish each license tag.

22 Application for the distinctive license tags authorized (2) by this section shall be made to the county tax collector on forms 23 24 prescribed by the Department of Revenue. The application and the 25 additional fee imposed under subsection (3) of this section, less 26 Two Dollars (\$2.00) thereof to be retained by the tax collector, 27 shall be remitted to the Department of Revenue on a monthly basis 28 as prescribed by the department. The portion of the additional 29 fee retained by the tax collector shall be deposited into the 30 county general fund.

Beginning with any registration year commencing on or 31 (3) after July 1, 2018, any person applying for a distinctive license 32 33 tag under this section shall pay an additional fee in the amount 34 of Thirty Dollars (\$30.00) for each distinctive license tag 35 applied for under this section, which shall be in addition to all other taxes and fees. The additional fee paid shall be for a 36 37 period of time to run concurrently with the vehicle's established license tag year. The additional fee is due and payable at the 38 time the original application is made for a distinctive license 39 40 tag under this section and thereafter annually at the time of 41 renewal registration as long as the owner retains the distinctive 42 license taq. If the owner does not wish to retain the distinctive 43 license tag, he must surrender it to the local county tax 44 collector.

45 (4) The Department of Revenue shall deposit all fees into 46 the State Treasury on the day collected. At the end of each month, the Department of Revenue shall certify to the State 47 Treasurer the total fees collected under this section from the 48 49 issuance of the distinctive license tags issued under this 50 section. The State Treasurer shall distribute such collections as follows: 51

52 (a) Twenty-four Dollars (\$24.00) of each additional fee
53 collected on distinctive license tags issued pursuant to this
54 section shall be distributed to the Brinkley High School Alumni
55 Association.

56 (b) One Dollar (\$1.00) of each additional fee collected 57 on distinctive license tags issued pursuant to this section shall 58 be deposited into the Mississippi Burn Care Fund created pursuant 59 to Section 7-9-70.

60 (c) Two Dollars (\$2.00) of each additional fee 61 collected on distinctive license tags issued pursuant to this 62 section shall be deposited to the credit of the State Highway Fund 63 to be expended solely for the repair, maintenance, construction or 64 reconstruction of highways.

(d) One Dollar (\$1.00) of each additional fee collected
on distinctive license tags issued pursuant to this section shall
be deposited to the credit of the special fund created in Section
27-19-44.2.

No. 492 18/HR26/R1031 PAGE 3 (BS\KW) 69 (5) A regular license tag must be properly displayed as 70 required by law until replaced by a distinctive license tag under 71 The regular license tag must be surrendered to the this section. 72 tax collector upon issuance of the distinctive license tag under 73 this section. The tax collector shall issue up to two (2) license 74 decals for each distinctive license tag issued under this section, 75 which will expire the same month and year as the regular license 76 tag.

77 In the case of loss or theft of a distinctive license (6)78 tag issued under this section, the owner may make application and 79 affidavit for a replacement distinctive license tag as provided by Section 27-19-37. The fee for a replacement distinctive license 80 81 tag shall be Ten Dollars (\$10.00). The tax collector receiving such application and affidavit shall be entitled to retain and 82 83 deposit into the county general fund five percent (5%) of the fee 84 for such replacement license tag and the remainder shall be distributed in the same manner as funds from the sale of regular 85 86 distinctive license tags issued under this section.

87 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 88 and after July 1, 2018.
