HOUSE BILL NO. 502

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 37-16-5, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO
REQUIRE LOCAL SCHOOL BOARDS TO ASSESS THE STUDENT PERFORMANCE OF
ALL ELEVENTH GRADE STUDENTS USING THE GENERAL EDUCATIONAL
DEVELOPMENT OR HIGH SCHOOL EQUIVALENCY TEST PROGRAM; TO PROHIBIT
STUDENTS DETERMINED BY THE ASSESSMENT TO BE PERFORMING BELOW GRADE
LEVEL FROM EXERCISING ANY SENIOR PRIVILEGE OF EARLY RELEASE FROM
SCHOOL UPON COMPLETION OF ALL ACADEMIC CLASSES REQUIRED FOR THE
DAY; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

- 9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 10 **SECTION 1.** Section 37-16-5, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 11 amended as follows:
- 12 37-16-5. (1) The school board of every district in this
- 13 state shall periodically assess student performance and
- 14 achievement in each school. Such assessment programs shall be
- 15 based upon local goals and objectives which are compatible with
- 16 the state's plan for education and which supplement the minimum
- 17 performance standards approved by the State Board of Education.
- 18 Data from district assessment programs shall be provided to the
- 19 State Department of Education when such data is required in order
- 20 to evaluate specific instructional programs or processes or when
- 21 the data is needed for other research or evaluation projects.

22	Each district may provide acceptable, compatible district
23	assessment data to substitute for any assessment data needed at
24	the state level when the State Department of Education certifies
25	that such data is acceptable for the purposes of Section 37-16-3.
26	(2) The school board of every school district shall assess
27	the performance of each student in Grade 11 through the
28	administration of the general educational development or High
29	School Equivalency Diploma Test Program as used by the Mississippi
30	Community College Board for adult basic education. The assessment
31	must be administered before the conclusion of the year in which a
32	student is enrolled in Grade 11. Any student whose performance on
33	the assessment demonstrates that the student is performing below
34	grade level may not exercise any privilege that may be granted by
35	the school district to seniors in that district for early release
36	during regular school hours upon completion of all academic
37	classes required for the day.
38	SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from

and after July 1, 2018.

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
