HOUSE BILL NO. 503

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 3-3-16, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO 1 2 CHANGE THE DESIGN OF THE OFFICIAL FLAG OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI; TO PROHIBIT THE PREVIOUS OFFICIAL STATE FLAG FROM 3 BEING FLOWN OR DISPLAYED ON OR IN ANY PUBLIC BUILDING OR OTHER 4 5 PUBLIC PROPERTY, EXCEPT IN A HISTORICAL EXHIBIT IN A PUBLIC 6 MUSEUM; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 8 SECTION 1. Section 3-3-16, Mississippi Code of 1972, is amended as follows: 9 10 3-3-16. The official flag of the State of Mississippi shall have the following design: * * * with width two-thirds (2/3) of 11 12 its length; the union (canton) to be square, bordered with white 13 on the fly side and the bottom side, in width two-thirds (2/3) the width of the flag, the ground of the union to be old glory blue, 14 15 and emblazoned with an outer circle of thirteen (13) five-pointed stars, an inner circle of six (6) five-pointed stars and a single 16 17 large five-pointed star in the center; the stars in the inner and 18 outer circle to be one-twelfth (1/12) the width of the flag, and 19 the center star to be one-eighth (1/8) the width of the flag, with 20 all stars to be pointed upward; the field to be divided into three H. B. No. 503 ~ OFFICIAL ~ G1/2 21 (3) bars of equal width, the upper one (1) old glory blue, the 22 center one (1) white and the lower one (1) old glory red. The 23 nineteen (19) stars surrounding the center star represent the 24 first nineteen (19) states admitted to the United States. The 25 center star represents the State of Mississippi and symbolizes 26 that Mississippi was the twentieth state admitted to the United 27 States.

28 **SECTION 2.** (1) The flag that was the official flag of the 29 State of Mississippi immediately before July 1, 2018, as described 30 in subsection (2) of this section, may not be flown or displayed 31 on or in any public building or other public property, except in a 32 historical exhibit in a public museum. The appropriate public agency or public official having jurisdiction over a public 33 34 building or public property shall enforce the provisions of this 35 section.

36 (2)The flag that was the official flag of the State of Mississippi before July 1, 2018, had the following design: with 37 width two-thirds (2/3) of its length; with the union (canton) to 38 39 be square, in width two-thirds (2/3) of the width of the flag; the ground of the union to be red and a broad blue saltire thereon, 40 41 bordered with white and emblazoned with thirteen (13) mullets or 42 five-pointed stars, corresponding with the number of the original 43 States of the Union; the field to be divided into three (3) bars 44 of equal width, the upper one (1) blue, the center one (1) white,

45 and the lower one (1), extending the whole length of the flag, red 46 (the national colors).

47 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from
