AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 21-15-33, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 1 2 TO REVISE THE PROCEDURE OF HOW MUNICIPAL MINUTES HAVE THE LEGAL 3 EFFECT OF BEING VALID AFTER A CERTAIN TIME PERIOD; AND FOR RELATED 4 PURPOSES. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 5 SECTION 1. Section 21-15-33, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 6 7 amended as follows: 21-15-33. The minutes of every municipality must be adopted 8 9 and *** * *** signed by a majority of all the members of the governing 10 body of the municipality at the next regular meeting or within thirty (30) days of the meeting thereof, whichever occurs first. 11 12 Upon *** * *** the signing of the minutes by a majority of all members of the governing body, * * * such minutes shall have the legal 13 14 effect of being valid from and after the date of the meeting. The governing body may by ordinance designate that the minutes be 15 16 approved by the mayor. 17 It shall not be necessary for each ordinance to be signed so long as it appears on the minutes of the municipality, which 18
