HOUSE BILL NO. 518

- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 37-103-25, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO WAIVE OUT-OF-STATE TUITION FEES FOR NONRESIDENT CHILDREN OF MISSISSIPPI EMERGENCY SERVICE PERSONNEL MEMBERS OR FIRST RESPONDERS EMPLOYED BY A POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OF THE STATE AND
- 5 WHO IS KILLED IN THE LINE OF DUTY; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 7 **SECTION 1.** Section 37-103-25, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 8 amended as follows:
- 9 37-103-25. (1) The Board of Trustees of State Institutions
- 10 of Higher Learning and the boards of trustees of the community
- 11 colleges and junior colleges are authorized to prescribe the
- 12 amount of tuition and fees to be paid by students attending the
- 13 several state-supported institutions of higher learning and
- 14 community colleges and junior colleges of the State of
- 15 Mississippi.
- 16 (2) Except as otherwise provided in this subsection and
- 17 subsections (3) and (4) of this section, the total tuition to be
- 18 paid by residents of other states shall not be less than the
- 19 average cost per student from appropriated funds. However, the

- 22 section if:
- 23 (a) The nonresident student is either a veteran, as
- 24 defined by Title 38 of the United States Code, or a person
- 25 entitled to education benefits under Title 38 of the United States
- 26 Code. Nonresident students enrolled in a professional school or
- 27 college at a state institution of higher learning are excluded
- 28 from this paragraph (2)(a) except for those nonresident students
- 29 who must be charged tuition equal to the amount established under
- 30 subsection (1) due to the provisions of Section 702 of the
- 31 Veterans Access, Choice and Accountability Act of 2014. This
- 32 paragraph (a) shall be administered and interpreted in the manner
- 33 necessary to obtain or retain approval of courses of education by
- 34 the Secretary of the United States Department of Veterans Affairs;
- 35 (b) The nonresident student is \star \star the child of a
- 36 Mississippi resident who is an emergency service personnel member
- 37 or first responder employed by a political subdivision of the
- 38 state, and who is killed in the line of duty; and
- 39 (c) The nonresident student's out-of-state tuition was
- 40 waived according to subsection (3) or (4) of this section.
- 41 (3) The Board of Trustees of State Institutions of Higher
- 42 Learning may, in its discretion, consider and grant requests to
- 43 approve institution specific policies permitting the waiver of
- 44 out-of-state tuition when such an official request is made by the

- 45 president or chancellor of the institution and when such request
- 46 is determined by the board to be fiscally responsible and in
- 47 accordance with the educational mission of the requesting
- 48 institution.
- 49 (4) The board of trustees of any community college or junior
- 50 college may develop and implement a policy for waiving
- 51 out-of-state tuition for the college if the policy is determined
- 52 by the board to be in accordance with the educational mission of
- 53 the college and if a local industry or business or a state agency
- 54 agrees to reimburse the college for the entire amount of the
- 55 out-of-state tuition that will be waived under the policy. State
- 56 funds shall be allocated and spent only on students who reside
- 57 within the State of Mississippi. However, associate degree
- 58 nursing students who reside outside the State of Mississippi may
- 59 be counted for pay purposes.
- 60 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 61 and after July 1, 2018.
