HOUSE BILL NO. 594 (As Passed the House)

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 1, CHAPTER 480, LAWS OF 2014, TO 2 AUTHORIZE THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION TO TRANSFER 3 CERTAIN REAL PROPERTY LOCATED ON CAPERS AVENUE WITHIN THE CITY OF 4 JACKSON, HINDS COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI, TO THE HINDS COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 5 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 7 SECTION 1. Section 1, Chapter 480, Laws of 2014, is amended 8 as follows: 9 Section 1. (1) The Department of Finance and Administration 10 is authorized to transfer and convey a certain tract or parcel of 11 real property to the Hinds County Board of Supervisors, that is 12 located on Capers Avenue in the City of Jackson, Hinds County, Mississippi, and is more particularly described as follows: 13 14 Starting at the concrete monument that is the SW corner 15 of the SE 1/2 of the SW 1/2 of Section 33, T6N-R1E in 16 the First Judicial District of Hinds County, 17 Mississippi, and being also within the corporate limits of the City of Jackson, run thence due East along the 18 19 line between Section 33, T6N-R1E and Section 4, T5N-R1E

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- 56 (** $\frac{1}{2}$) The state shall retain all mineral rights in the 57 property.
- (* * *<u>3</u>) The Department of Finance and Administration is vested with the authority to correct any discrepancies in the legal description of the property described in subsection (1) of this section.
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- 63 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 64 and after its passage.
