HOUSE BILL NO. 600

- AN ACT TO CREATE THE "MISSISSIPPI MANDATORY IDENTIFICATION ACT"; TO PROVIDE THE AUTHORIZED FORMS OF IDENTIFICATION; TO
- 3 PROVIDE PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS OF THIS ACT; AND FOR RELATED
- 4 PURPOSES.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 6 **SECTION 1.** This act shall be known and may be referred to as
- 7 the "Mississippi Mandatory Identification Act."
- 8 **SECTION 2.** (1) Any person who is twelve (12) years of age
- 9 or older shall be required to possess a form of photograph
- 10 identification, and shall have such identification in their
- 11 possession at all times. The following forms of photograph
- 12 identification shall be acceptable:
- 13 (a) Any form of photograph identification authorized
- 14 for voter identification under Section 23-15-563; or
- 15 (b) Any form of photograph identification from a
- 16 recognized educational institution.
- 17 (2) Any person who violates the provisions of subsection
- 18 (1), shall be penalized as follows:

- 19 (a) First offense, shall be fined up to Fifty Dollars
- 20 (\$50.00), and if such person fails to pay such fine within thirty
- 21 (30) days after the court order, then, at the discretion of the
- 22 judge, such person shall be ordered to perform up to ten (10)
- 23 hours of community service;
- 24 (b) Second offense, shall be fined in an amount of more
- 25 than Fifty Dollars (\$50.00), but not to exceed an amount One
- 26 Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$150.00), and if such person fails to pay
- 27 such fine within thirty (30) days after the court order, then, at
- 28 the discretion of the judge, such person shall be ordered to
- 29 perform up to twenty-five (25) hours of community service.
- 30 (c) Third or subsequent offense, shall be fined in an
- 31 amount of not less than One Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$150.00), but
- 32 not to exceed an amount of Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250.00),
- 33 and if such person fails to pay such fine within thirty (30) days
- 34 after the court order, then, at the discretion of the judge, such
- 35 person shall be ordered to perform up to forty (40) hours of
- 36 community service.
- 37 **SECTION 3.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 38 and after July 1, 2018.
