- inform consumers, at the final point of sale of the covered 8
- 9 commodity to consumers, of the country of origin of the covered
- 10 commodity.
- 11 (2) (a) The information * * * shall be provided to
- consumers by means of a label, stamp, mark, placard or other clear 12
- 13 and visible sign on the covered commodity or on the package,
- 14 display, holding unit or bin containing the commodity at the final
- 15 point of sale to consumers.
- 16 (b) If the covered commodity is already individually
- labeled for retail sale regarding country of origin, the retailer 17

- 18 shall not be required to provide any additional information to
- 19 comply with this section.
- 20 (3) A supplier shall provide information to the retailer
- 21 indicating the country of origin of the covered commodity.
- 22 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 23 and after July 1, 2018.
