HOUSE BILL NO. 603

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 9-7-25, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO 2 REVISE THE NUMBER OF CIRCUIT JUDGES IN THE SEVENTH CIRCUIT COURT 3 DISTRICT OF HINDS COUNTY; TO AMEND SECTION 9-7-23, MISSISSIPPI 4 CODE OF 1972, TO CONFORM TO THE PRECEDING SECTION; AND FOR RELATED 5 PURPOSES.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 7 SECTION 1. Section 9-7-25, Mississippi Code of 1972, is

8 amended as follows:

9 9-7-25. (1) There shall be * * * <u>five (5)</u> circuit judges
10 for the Seventh Circuit Court District. One (1) judge shall be
11 elected from each subdistrict.

12 (2) While there shall be no limitation whatsoever upon the 13 powers and duties of the said judges other than as cast upon them 14 by the Constitution and laws of this state, the court in the First 15 Judicial District of Hinds County, in the discretion of the senior 16 circuit judge, may be divided into civil and criminal divisions as 17 a matter of convenience, by the entry of an order upon the minutes 18 of the court.

This act shall take effect and be in force from and after July 1, 2018. 36
