HOUSE BILL NO. 640

- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 47-5-139, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972,
- 2 TO PROVIDE THAT IF AN INMATE WAS NOT SENTENCED TO LIFE
- 3 IMPRISONMENT FOR CAPITAL MURDER AND HE OR SHE HAS REACHED 65 YEARS
- 4 OF AGE AND HAS SERVED A MINIMUM OF 15 YEARS OF HIS OR HER
- 5 SENTENCE, THEN SUCH INMATE IS ELIGIBLE FOR EARNED TIME ALLOWANCE;
- 6 AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 8 **SECTION 1.** Section 47-5-139, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 9 amended as follows:
- 10 47-5-139. (1) An inmate shall not be eligible for the
- 11 earned time allowance if:
- 12 (a) Except as otherwise provided, the inmate was
- 13 sentenced to life imprisonment; * * * however, an inmate * * * who
- 14 has reached the age of sixty-five (65) or older \star \star , who has
- 15 served at least fifteen (15) years, and has not been sentenced to
- 16 life imprisonment for capital murder, may petition the sentencing
- 17 court for conditional release;
- 18 (b) The inmate was convicted as a habitual offender
- 19 under Sections 99-19-81 through 99-19-87;

20	(C)	The	inmate	has	forfeited	his	earned	time	allowance

- 21 by order of the commissioner;
- 22 (d) The inmate was convicted of a sex crime; or
- 23 (e) The inmate has not served the mandatory time
- 24 required for parole eligibility for a conviction of robbery or
- 25 attempted robbery with a deadly weapon.
- 26 (2) An offender under two (2) or more consecutive sentences
- 27 shall be allowed commutation based upon the total term of the
- 28 sentences.
- 29 (3) All earned time shall be forfeited by the inmate in the
- 30 event of escape and/or aiding and abetting an escape. The
- 31 commissioner may restore all or part of the earned time if the
- 32 escapee returns to the institution voluntarily, without expense to
- 33 the state, and without act of violence while a fugitive from the
- 34 facility.
- 35 (4) Any officer or employee who shall willfully violate the
- 36 provisions of this section and be convicted therefor shall be
- 37 removed from office or employment.
- 38 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 39 and after July 1, 2018.
