HOUSE BILL NO. 658

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 73-11-65, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 1 2 TO AUTHORIZE FUNERAL DIRECTOR ASSISTANTS TO PERFORM ALL OF THE 3 ACTIVITIES THAT A FUNERAL DIRECTOR MAY PERFORM EXCEPT FOR MAKING 4 FUNERAL ARRANGEMENTS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 5 SECTION 1. Section 73-11-65, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 6 7 amended as follows: 8 73-11-65. (1) Every funeral service or interment, or part 9 thereof, that is conducted in Mississippi must be in the actual 10 charge and under the supervision of a funeral director or funeral service licensee who is licensed under this chapter. However, 11 12 this section shall not prevent a family from burying its own dead 13 without charge. 14 (2) A funeral director assistant, under the supervision of a licensed funeral director, may perform all of the activities that 15 16 a funeral director may perform except for making funeral 17 arrangements. SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 18 19 and after July 1, 2018.
