HOUSE BILL NO. 675

1 AN ACT TO PROHIBIT LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS FROM USING 2 BODY-WORN CAMERAS TO RECREATE PAST ENCOUNTERS; TO PROHIBIT VIDEO 3 AND AUDIO FOOTAGE CAPTURED BY BODY-WORN CAMERAS OTHER THAN FROM 4 ACTUAL REAL-TIME ENCOUNTERS FROM BEING USED IN CRIMINAL 5 PROCEEDINGS; TO REQUIRE LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES UTILIZING 6 BODY-WORN CAMERAS TO ADOPT POLICIES GOVERNING THEIR USAGE; AND FOR 7 RELATED PURPOSES. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 8 9 SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section, the following words and phrases have the meanings ascribed in this subsection unless 10 11 the context clearly indicates otherwise: 12 (a) "Body-worn camera" means a portable electronic recording device that is worn on a law enforcement officer's body 13 14 and which records audio and video in the course of the officer performing his or her activities. 15 16 (b) "Law enforcement officer" means the same as that term is defined in Section 45-6-3. 17 18 (2) A body-worn camera worn by a law enforcement officer in the State of Mississippi may not be used for the purpose of 19 staging, reenacting or in any other manner recreating a past 20

(3) Video and audio footage recorded in violation of this
section may not be used as evidence in criminal proceedings
instituted against a person who was a subject of the law
enforcement encounter or activity.

(4) Each state and local agency that issues body-worn
cameras to law enforcement officers employed by that agency shall
adopt a policy governing the use of body-worn cameras. The policy
must include, at a minimum, the provisions of this section.

33 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 34 and after July 1, 2018.
