## HOUSE BILL NO. 712

- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 37-19-10, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO CLARIFY THAT SCHOOL RECOGNITION SUPPLEMENTS SHALL BE AVAILABLE FOR ALL CERTIFIED TEACHERS, LICENSED VOCATIONAL TEACHERS AND CERTIFIED STAFF; TO PROVIDE THAT ANY NONRECURRING SALARY 5 SUPPLEMENT SHALL BE PAID IN A SINGLE PAYMENT; TO PROVIDE FOR THE
- ISSUANCE OF SUPPLEMENTAL CONTRACT FOR ALL CERTIFIED TEACHERS,
- 7 LICENSED VOCATIONAL TEACHERS AND CERTIFIED STAFF RECEIVING THE
- SUPPLEMENT AWARD; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 8
- 9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 10 SECTION 1. Section 37-19-10, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- amended as follows: 11
- 12 37-19-10. (1) The Legislature finds that there is a need
- for a performance incentive program for outstanding teachers and 13
- 14 staff in highly productive schools.
- Beginning with the 2016-2017 school year, the School 15
- 16 Recognition Program is created to provide financial awards to
- 17 public schools that:
- Sustain high performance by earning a school 18
- 19 accountability rating of "A" which shall be funded at One Hundred
- 20 Dollars (\$100.00) per pupil in average daily attendance;

- 22 accountability rating of "B" which shall be funded at Seventy-five
- 23 Dollars (\$75.00) per pupil in average daily attendance; or
- 24 (c) Demonstrate exemplary performance by improving at
- 25 least one (1) letter grade, which shall be funded at One Hundred
- 26 Dollars (\$100.00) per pupil in average daily attendance.
- 27 (3) All public schools, including charter schools, earning
- 28 the appropriate school rating are eligible to participate in the
- 29 program.
- 30 (4) School recognition awards must be used for nonrecurring
- 31 salary supplements to the certified teachers, licensed vocational
- 32 teachers and certified staff employed in the school receiving the
- 33 financial award. Any nonrecurring salary supplements paid to
- 34 teachers and staff shall be prospective, shall be paid \* \* \* in a
- 35 single payment, and shall not be considered part of the local
- 36 supplement. \* \* \* Supplemental contracts will be issued to all
- 37 certified teachers, licensed vocational teachers and certified
- 38 staff receiving the supplement award.
- 39 (5) School recognition awards shall not be used for
- 40 administrators.
- 41 (6) There is hereby created in the State Treasury, the
- 42 School Recognition Program Fund which shall be used by the State
- 43 Department of Education, depending on the availability of funds as
- 44 appropriated, to provide financial awards to schools under this
- 45 section. It shall be the duty of the State Department of

46	Education to file with the State Treasurer and the State Fiscal
47	Officer such data and information as may be required to enable the
48	said State Treasurer and State Fiscal Officer to distribute the
49	School Recognition Program Funds by electronic funds transfer to
50	the several school districts at the time required and provided
51	under the provisions of this section. Such data and information
52	so filed shall show in detail the amount of funds to which each
53	school district is entitled from the School Recognition Program
54	Fund. Such data and information so filed may be revised from time
55	to time as necessitated by law. At the time provided by law, the
56	State Treasurer and the State Fiscal Officer shall distribute to
57	the several school districts the amounts to which they are
58	entitled from the School Recognition Program Fund as provided by
59	this section. Such distribution shall be made by electronic funds
60	transfer to the depositories of the several school districts
61	designated in writing to the State Treasurer based upon the data
62	and information supplied by the State Department of Education for
63	such distribution. In such instances, the State Treasurer shall
64	submit a request for an electronic funds transfer to the State
65	Fiscal Officer, which shall set forth the purpose, amount and
66	payees, and shall be in such form as may be approved by the State
67	Fiscal Officer so as to provide the necessary information as would
68	be required for a requisition and issuance of a warrant. A copy
69	of the record of said electronic funds transfers shall be
70	transmitted by the school district depositories to the Treasurer,

- 71 who shall file duplicates with the State Fiscal Officer. The
- 72 Treasurer and State Fiscal Officer shall jointly promulgate
- 73 regulations for the utilization of electronic funds transfers to
- 74 school districts from the School Recognition Program Fund.
- 75 (7) It is the intent of the Legislature to develop a plan to
- 76 reward high-performing teachers in schools with an accountability
- 77 rating of "C," "D" and "F" by July 1, 2016.
- 78 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 79 and after July 1, 2018.
