(1) In any claim or suit for damages against a 7 governmental entity or its employee brought under the provisions 8 9 of this chapter, the liability shall not exceed the following for all claims arising out of a single occurrence for all damages 10 permitted under this chapter: 11 12 For claims or causes of action arising from acts or (a) omissions occurring on or after July 1, 1993, but before July 1, 13 14 1997, the sum of Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00); (b) For claims or causes of action arising from acts or 15 omissions occurring on or after July 1, 1997, but before July 1, 16 2001, the sum of Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$250,000.00); 17
