HOUSE BILL NO. 822

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 37-11-54, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972,
TO REQUIRE SCHOOL DISTRICTS TO SUBMIT A REPORT BY JULY 31 OF EACH
CALENDAR YEAR TO THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION DESCRIBING HOW
IT INCORPORATES EVIDENCE-BASED PRACTICES AND POSITIVE BEHAVIORAL
INTERVENTION SUPPORTS INTO ITS POLICIES AND CODES OF CONDUCT; AND
FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

- 7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 8 **SECTION 1.** Section 37-11-54, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 9 amended as follows:
- 10 37-11-54. The State Board of Education shall develop a list
- 11 of recommended conflict resolution and mediation materials, models
- 12 and curricula that are developed from evidence-based practices and
- 13 positive behavioral intervention supports to address responsible
- 14 decision making, the causes and effects of school violence and
- 15 harassment, cultural diversity \* \* \* and nonviolent methods for
- 16 resolving conflict, including peer mediation, and shall make the
- 17 list available to local school administrative units and school
- 18 buildings before the beginning of the 2007-2008 school year. In
- 19 addition, local school boards shall incorporate evidence-based
- 20 practices and positive behavioral intervention supports into

- 22 school district shall submit a report by July 31 of each calendar
- 23 year to the State Department of Education describing how it
- 24 incorporates evidence-based practices and positive behavioral
- 25 intervention supports into its policies and Codes of Conduct. The
- 26 report shall only include the portion of each policy and Codes of
- 27 Conduct that incorporates evidence-based practices and positive
- 28 behavioral intervention. In developing this list, the board shall
- 29 emphasize materials, models and curricula that currently are being
- 30 used in Mississippi and that the board determines to be effective.
- 31 The board shall include at least one (1) model that includes
- 32 instruction and guidance for the voluntary implementation of peer
- 33 mediation programs and one (1) model that provides instruction and
- 34 quidance for teachers concerning the integration of conflict
- 35 resolution and mediation lessons into the existing classroom
- 36 curriculum.
- 37 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 38 and after July 1, 2018.
