HOUSE BILL NO. 824

1 AN ACT TO CREATE A SPECIAL FUND IN THE STATE TREASURY TO BE 2 KNOWN AS THE "MISSISSIPPI STATEWIDE CRIME PREVENTION INITIATIVE 3 FUND; " TO PROVIDE THAT ALL FUNDS RECEIVED BY ANY STATE ENTITY FROM THE UNITED STATES BUREAU OF JUSTICE ASSISTANCE'S EDWARD BYRNE 5 MEMORIAL JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT PROGRAM SHALL BE DEPOSITED INTO 6 THE SPECIAL FUND; TO PROVIDE THAT THE MONIES IN THIS FUND SHALL BE 7 EXPENDED, UPON APPROPRIATION BY THE LEGISLATURE, ONLY ON 8 EVIDENCE-BASED CRIME PREVENTION PROGRAMS, DRUG TREATMENT PROGRAMS, 9 INDIGENT DEFENSE AND COMMUNITY CORRECTIONS PROGRAMS; TO PROVIDE 10 THAT IN MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FROM THE FUND, THE LEGISLATURE SHALL 11 CONSIDER THE RECOMMENDATIONS OF AN ADVISORY COMMITTEE; TO PROVIDE 12 THAT CIRCUIT COURT CLERKS SHALL FORWARD REPORTS OF INDIVIDUALS 13 BEING HELD FOR TRIAL, GRAND JURY ACTION OR EXTRADITION, SUBMITTED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE MISSISSIPPI RULES OF CRIMINAL PROCEDURE, 14 15 RULE 8.5(C), TO THE ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICE OF COURTS, THE ATTORNEY 16 GENERAL, AND THE OFFICE OF STATE PUBLIC DEFENDER; AND FOR RELATED 17 PURPOSES. 18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 19 SECTION 1. (1) All funds received by any state entity from 20 the United States Bureau of Justice Assistance's Edward Byrne 21 Memorial Justice Assistance Grant Program shall be deposited into 22 a special fund that is created in the State Treasury to be known 23 as the "Mississippi Statewide Crime Prevention Initiative Fund." 24 The monies in the fund shall be expended, upon appropriation by 25 the Legislature, only on evidence-based crime prevention programs,

- 26 drug treatment programs, indigent defense and community
- 27 corrections programs.
- 28 (2) In making appropriations from the fund, the Legislature
- 29 shall consider the recommendations of an advisory committee
- 30 composed of one (1) representative designated by each of the
- 31 following entities: Department of Public Safety, Department of
- 32 Corrections, Office of State Public Defender, Department of
- 33 Education, Mississippi Association of Chiefs of Police and
- 34 Mississippi Sheriffs' Association.
- 35 (3) Money remaining in the fund at the end of a fiscal year
- 36 shall not lapse into the State General Fund, and any interest
- 37 earned from the investment of monies in the fund shall be
- 38 deposited to the credit of the fund.
- 39 **SECTION 2.** Circuit court clerks shall forward reports of
- 40 individuals being held for trial, grand jury action or
- 41 extradition, submitted in accordance with the Mississippi Rules of
- 42 Criminal Procedure, Rule 8.5(c), to the Administrative Office of
- 43 Courts, the Attorney General, and the Office of State Public
- 44 Defender.
- 45 **SECTION 3.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 46 and after July 1, 2018.
