HOUSE BILL NO. 945

- 21 The board of trustees shall, by appropriate orders spread upon its
- 22 minutes, authorize its chief executive officer or president to
- 23 expend such funds for lawful purposes only and in accordance with
- 24 its annual budget previously adopted.
- The board of trustees may require its designated employees,
- 26 including its president, and fiscal agents to enter into and file
- 27 with the president of the college a surety bond to insure the
- 28 faithful performance of the public duties of each officer or agent
