## HOUSE BILL NO. 954

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 19-25-31, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO INCREASE, AT THE JUDGE'S DISCRETION, THE AMOUNT COMPENSATED TO RIDING BAILIFFS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 5 **SECTION 1.** Section 19-25-31, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 6 amended as follows:
- 7 19-25-31. Each judge of a circuit, chancery or county court,
- 8 or a court of eminent domain may, in the judge's discretion, by
- 9 order entered on the minutes of the court, allow the sheriff
- 10 riding bailiffs to serve in the respective court of such judge,
- 11 not to exceed four (4) bailiffs. Any such person so employed
- 12 shall be paid by the county on allowances of the court on issuance
- of a warrant therefor in an amount of Fifty-five Dollars (\$55.00)
- 14 for each day, or part thereof, for which he or she serves as
- 15 bailiff when the court is in session. Any such person so employed
- 16 may be paid, at the judge's discretion, by the county on
- 17 allowances of the court on issuance of a warrant therefor in an
- additional amount of Seventy Dollars (\$70.00) for each day, or

- 19 part thereof, for which he or she serves as a bailiff when the
- 20 court is in session. No full-time deputy sheriff shall be paid as
- 21 a riding bailiff of any court. County court judges shall be
- 22 limited to one (1) bailiff per each court day.
- 23 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 24 and after July 1, 2018.
