## HOUSE BILL NO. 1005

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 65-37-13, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 2 TO INCREASE THE AMOUNT THE LEGISLATURE SHALL APPROPRIATE TO THE 3 LOCAL SYSTEM BRIDGE REPLACEMENT AND REHABILITATION PROGRAM 4 BEGINNING IN 2018 IN YEARS THAT CERTAIN GROWTH REVENUE ESTIMATES 5 ARE ACHIEVED THE PRECEDING YEAR; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 7 SECTION 1. Section 65-37-13, Mississippi Code of 1972, is amended as follows: 8 9 65-37-13. (1) There is created in the State Treasury a 10 special fund to be designated as the "Local System Bridge Replacement and Rehabilitation Fund." The fund shall consist of 11 12 monies that the Legislature appropriates under subsection (2) of 13 this section, the proceeds of bonds issued under Section 10 of Chapter 557, Laws of 2009, and any other monies that the 14 15 Legislature may designate for deposit into the fund. Monies in the fund may be expended upon legislative appropriation in 16 17 accordance with the provisions of Sections 65-37-1 through 18 65-37-15.

No. 1005 18/HR12/R145 PAGE 1 (CAA\AM) 19 (2)(a) During each regular legislative session held in 20 calendar years 1995, 1996, 1997 and 1998, if the official General 21 Fund revenue estimate for the succeeding fiscal year for which 22 appropriations are being made reflects a growth in General Fund revenues of three percent (3%) or more for that succeeding fiscal 23 24 year, then the Legislature shall appropriate Twenty-five Million Dollars (\$25,000,000.00) from the State General Fund for deposit 25 26 into the Local System Bridge Replacement and Rehabilitation Fund.

27 During the regular legislative session held in (b) calendar year 1999, if the official General Fund revenue estimate 28 29 for the succeeding fiscal year for which appropriations are being 30 made reflects a growth in General Fund revenues of two percent 31 (2%) or more for the succeeding fiscal year, then the Legislature 32 shall appropriate Ten Million Dollars (\$10,000,000.00) from the 33 State General Fund for deposit into the Local System Bridge 34 Replacement and Rehabilitation Fund.

35 Except as otherwise provided in this paragraph (c), (C) during each regular legislative session held in calendar years 36 37 2001 through 2017, if the official General Fund revenue estimate 38 for the succeeding fiscal year for which appropriations are being 39 made reflects a growth in General Fund revenues of two percent 40 (2%) or more for the succeeding fiscal year, then the Legislature shall appropriate Twenty Million Dollars (\$20,000,000.00) from the 41 42 State General Fund for deposit into the Local System Bridge Replacement and Rehabilitation Fund. However, during the regular 43

44 legislative sessions held in calendar years 2003, 2004, 2005, 45 2006, 2007, 2008, 2009, 2010, 2011, 2014, 2015 and 2016 the Legislature shall not be required to appropriate funds for deposit 46 47 into the Local System Bridge Replacement and Rehabilitation Fund. 48 (d) Beginning with the regular legislative session held 49 in calendar year 2018 and in each regular legislative session held 50 thereafter, if the official General Fund revenue estimate for the 51 succeeding fiscal year for which appropriations are being made 52 reflects a growth in General Fund revenues of two percent (2%) or 53 more for the succeeding fiscal year, then the Legislature shall 54 appropriate Sixty Million Dollars (\$60,000,000.00) from the State 55 General Fund for deposit into the Local System Bridge Replacement 56 and Rehabilitation Fund.

57 Monies that are deposited into the fund under the (3) 58 provisions of this section may be expended upon requisition 59 therefor by the State Aid Engineer in accordance with the 60 provisions of Sections 65-37-1 through 65-37-15. The Office of State Aid Road Construction shall be entitled to reimbursement 61 62 from monies in the fund, upon requisitions therefor by the State 63 Aid Engineer, for the actual expenses incurred by the office in 64 administering the provisions of the Local System Bridge Replacement and Rehabilitation Program. Unexpended amounts 65 remaining in the fund at the end of a fiscal year shall not lapse 66 67 into the State General Fund, and any interest earned on amounts in the fund shall be deposited to the credit of the fund. 68

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69 (4) Monies in the Local System Bridge Replacement and 70 Rehabilitation Fund shall be allocated and become available for 71 distribution to counties in accordance with the formula prescribed 72 in Section 65-37-3 beginning January 1, 1995, on a 73 project-by-project basis. Monies in the Local System Bridge 74 Replacement and Rehabilitation Fund may not be used or expended 75 for any purpose except as authorized under Sections 65-37-1 76 through 65-37-15.

(5) Monies in the Local System Bridge Replacement and Rehabilitation Fund may be credited to a county in advance of the normal accrual to finance certain projects, subject to the approval of the State Aid Engineer and subject further to the following limitations:

(a) That the maximum amount of such monies that may be
advanced to any county shall not exceed ninety percent (90%) of
the funds estimated to accrue to such county during the remainder
of the term of office of the board of supervisors of such county;

(b) That no advance credit of funds will be made to any
county when the unobligated balance in the Local System Bridge
Replacement and Rehabilitation Fund is less than One Million
Dollars (\$1,000,000.00); and

90 (c) That such advance crediting of funds be effected by 91 the State Aid Engineer at the time of the approval of the plans 92 and specifications for the proposed projects.

93 It is the intent of this provision to utilize to the fullest 94 practicable extent the balance of monies in the Local System 95 Bridge Replacement and Rehabilitation Fund on hand at all times. 96 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 97 and after its passage.
