1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 19-23-13, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 2 TO AUTHORIZE A COUNTY PROSECUTING ATTORNEY TO REPRESENT DEFENDANTS 3 OUTSIDE OF THE COUNTY OF THE PROSECUTING ATTORNEY; AND FOR RELATED 4 PURPOSES.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 6 SECTION 1. Section 19-23-13, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 7 amended as follows:

8 19-23-13. The county prosecuting attorney shall not 9 represent or defend any person in any criminal prosecution in the 10 name of the state, county or municipality of the county, nor shall he or she give any advice against the state, his or her county or 11 12 in a criminal case against a municipality of his or her county, and shall not represent any person in any case against the state, 13 14 his or her county, or in a criminal case arising in a municipal court of his or her county. Nothing herein shall prohibit any 15 county prosecuting attorney from defending any person in any 16 17 criminal prosecution **\* \* \*** outside the county prosecuting

18 <u>attorney's county</u>.
