HOUSE BILL NO. 1060

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 37-16-7, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO 2 REQUIRE EACH COHORT OF STUDENTS BEGINNING WITH THOSE GRADUATING IN 3 2020 TO TAKE A MINIMUM OF ONE ONLINE COURSE, AS DEFINED AND 4 APPROVED BY THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION; AND FOR RELATED 5 PURPOSES. 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 7 SECTION 1. Section 37-16-7, Mississippi Code of 1972, is amended as follows: 8 37-16-7. (1) Each district school board shall establish 9 10 standards for graduation from its schools which shall include as a 11 minimum: 12 (a) Mastery of minimum academic skills as measured by assessments developed and administered by the State Board of 13 14 Education. 15 (b) Completion of a minimum number of academic credits, 16 and all other applicable requirements prescribed by the district 17 school board. 18 Completion of a minimum of one (1) online course, (C) 19 as defined and approved by the State Department of Education, G1/2H. 20 <u>beginning with the cohort of students graduating in 2020 and each</u> 21 year thereafter.

(***<u>d</u>) By school, information on high school graduation rates. High schools with graduation rates lower than eighty percent (80%) must submit a detailed plan to the * * * <u>State</u> Department of Education to restructure the high school experience to improve graduation rates.

(2) A student who meets all requirements prescribed in
subsection (1) of this section shall be awarded a standard diploma
in a form prescribed by the State Board of Education.

30 (3) The State Board of Education may establish student 31 proficiency standards for promotion to grade levels leading to 32 graduation.

33 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 34 and after July 1, 2018.
