HOUSE BILL NO. 1082

1 AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND 2 ADMINISTRATION, ACTING ON BEHALF OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF STATE 3 INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER LEARNING, TO CONVEY CERTAIN STATE-OWNED 4 REAL PROPERTY LOCATED IN COAHOMA COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI, TO THE BOARD 5 OF TRUSTEES OF COAHOMA COMMUNITY COLLEGE; TO REQUIRE THE BOARD OF 6 TRUSTEES OF COAHOMA COMMUNITY COLLEGE TO CARRY OUT CERTAIN 7 FUNCTIONS RELATIVE TO THE MANAGEMENT AND OPERATION OF THE COAHOMA 8 COUNTY HIGHER EDUCATION CENTER; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 10 **SECTION 1.** (1) The Department of Finance and 11 Administration, acting on behalf of the Board of Trustees of State 12 Institutions of Higher Learning, is authorized to donate, transfer and convey for no consideration to the Board of Trustees of 13 14 Coahoma Community College, for the use and benefit of the Coahoma County Higher Education Center, the following real property in 15 16 Coahoma County, Mississippi, known as the Cutrer Mansion lot, St. Elizabeth School lot, and St. Elizabeth Gymnasium lot: 17 A parcel of land which is situate in Section Fourteen 18 19 (14), Township Twenty-Seven (27) North, Range Four (4) 20 West, Coahoma County, Mississippi, described by metes 21 and bounds as follows, to wit: G1/2 H. B. No. 1082 ~ OFFICIAL ~

22 Beginning at a point where the center line of John 23 Street, in Clarksdale, Mississippi, intersects the north 24 line of Clark Street in Clarksdale, Mississippi, thence 25 South seventy-five (75) degrees, thirty-eight (38) 26 minutes West three hundred ninety-six and 25/100 27 (396.25) feet along the north line of Clark Street to a point, which point is the point of beginning; thence 28 North fourteen (14) degrees, twenty-two (22) minutes 29 30 West two hundred two (202) feet to a point; thence North two (2) degrees forty-six (46) minutes East four hundred 31 forty-seven and two-tenths (447.2) feet to a stake in 32 33 the center of Mill Bayou; thence in a westerly direction 34 along the center line of Mill Bayou to its intersection 35 with the East line of the Clarksdale-Friars Point public road; thence South twenty-nine (29) minutes West along 36 37 said East line of said public road to the intersection with the North line of Clark Street extended in a 38 westerly direction; thence in an easterly direction 39 40 along the North line of Clark Street extended in a 41 westerly direction along the North line of Clark Street 42 to the point of beginning.

43 Together with all improvements situated thereon and 44 all appurtenances thereunto belonging, LESS AND EXCEPT 45 all easements and rights-of-way record.

47 be responsible for the management and upkeep of the above48 described property, as well as any facilities thereon and any
49 improvements that may at some future date be constructed on the
50 site.

51 (3) The Board of Trustees of Coahoma Community College shall 52 ensure that the Coahoma County Higher Education Center carries out 53 the purposes of providing higher education, workforce training, 54 and/or other continuing education opportunities to the public at 55 the above-described property. The Department of Finance and 56 Administration and the institutions of higher learning are 57 authorized to convey the above described property on the condition 58 that it shall be used for such purposes and further provided that 59 the property shall revert to the state in the event that the Board 60 of Trustees of Coahoma Community College should operate the center 61 contrary to such purposes, abandons such property or attempts to 62 sell or transfer all or a portion of such property to another 63 entity.

64 (4) The Department of Finance and Administration is
65 authorized to correct any discrepancies in the legal description
66 of the property provided in subsection (1) of this section.

(5) The State of Mississippi shall retain all mineral rights
to the real property conveyed and transferred under this section.
SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
and after its passage.
