6	SECTION 1. Section 35-1-3, Mississippi Code of 1972, is

8	35-1-3. The State Veterans Affairs Board shall appoint, to
9	serve at the will and pleasure of the board, an executive
10	director, (who shall also serve as Executive Secretary of the
11	State Veterans Affairs Board), a deputy director, individuals to
12	manage each of the agency's major functional areas and individuals
13	to manage each of the state veterans homes. The executive
14	director and deputy director shall $\underline{\text{not}}$ be * * $\underline{\text{dishonorably}}$
