HOUSE BILL NO. 1189

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTIONS 63-1-35 AND 45-35-3, MISSISSIPPI 2 CODE OF 1972, TO REQUIRE THE COMMISSIONER OF PUBLIC SAFETY TO 3 PROVIDE IDENTIFYING MARKINGS ON THE DRIVER'S LICENSE OR 4 IDENTIFICATION CARD OF CURRENT AND FORMER MEMBERS OF THE 5 MISSISSIPPI LEGISLATURE UPON REQUEST; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 7 SECTION 1. Section 63-1-35, Mississippi Code of 1972, is amended as follows: 8 9 63-1-35. (1) The Commissioner of Public Safety shall 10 prescribe the form of license issued pursuant to this article which shall, among other features, include a driver's license 11 12 number assigned by the Department of Public Safety. A licensee shall list his social security number with the department which 13 14 shall cross reference the social security number with the driver's 15 license number for purposes of identification. Additionally, each 16 license shall bear a full-face color photograph of the licensee in 17 such form that the license and the photograph cannot be separated. The photograph shall be taken so that one (1) exposure will 18 19 photograph the applicant and the application simultaneously on the

The department shall use a process in the issuance of 21 a license with a color photograph that shall prevent as nearly as 22 possible any alteration, counterfeiting, duplication, reproduction, forging or modification of the license or the 23 24 superimposition of a photograph without ready detection. The 25 photograph shall be replaced by the department at the time of 26 Drivers' licenses, including photographs appearing renewal. 27 thereon, may be renewed by electronic means according to rules and 28 regulations promulgated by the commissioner in conformity to 29 Section 27-104-33.

30 (2) The commissioner shall prescribe the form of license 31 issued pursuant to this article to licensees who are not United 32 States citizens and who do not possess a social security number 33 issued by the United States government. The license of such 34 persons shall include a number and/or other identifying features.

(3) Any new, renewal or duplicate driver's license,
temporary driving permit, intermediate license or commercial
driver's license issued to a person required to register as a sex
offender pursuant to Section 45-33-25 shall bear a designation
identifying the licensee or permittee as a sex offender.

40 (4) The commissioner is authorized to provide the new, 41 renewal or duplicate driver's license, temporary driving permit, 42 intermediate license or commercial driver's license to any 43 honorably discharged veteran as defined in Title 38 of the United 44 States Code, and such license or permit shall exhibit the letters

The 46 veteran requesting the "Vet" designation shall present his DD-214 47 or equivalent document that includes a notation from the state 48 Veterans Affairs Board that the applicant is a veteran.

49 (5) Upon request and proof by a current or former member of 50 the Mississippi Legislature, the commissioner shall provide that 51 the new, renewal or duplicate driver's license, temporary driving 52 permit, intermediate license or commercial driver's license of the 53 current or former member of the Mississippi Legislature shall be 54 marked to identify the person as either a current or former member 55 of the Legislature.

56 SECTION 2. Section 45-35-3, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 57 amended as follows:

45-35-3. (1) Any person six (6) years of age or older may be issued an identification card by the department which is certified by the registrant and attested by the commissioner as to true name, correct age and such other identifying data as required by Section 45-35-5.

(2) The new, renewal or duplicate identification card of a
person required to register as a sex offender pursuant to Section
45-33-25 shall bear a designation identifying the cardholder as a
sex offender.

The 72 veteran requesting the "Vet" designation shall present his DD-214 73 or equivalent document that includes a notation from the state 74 Veterans Affairs Board that the applicant is a veteran.

75 (4) Upon request and proof by a current or former member of 76 the Mississippi Legislature, the commissioner shall provide that 77 the identification card of the current or former member of the 78 Mississippi Legislature shall be marked to identify the person as 79 either a current or former member of the Legislature. 80 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from 81 and after July 1, 2018.
