Nothing in this chapter shall apply to acts * * * 7 8 or practices: 9 Done by the publisher, owner, agent or employee of (a) 10 a newspaper, periodical, printing shop, directory, website 11 provider or radio or television station in the publication or 12 dissemination of an advertisement, when the owner, agent or 13 employee did not have knowledge of the false, misleading or 14 deceptive character of the advertisement and did not have a direct financial interest in the sale or distribution of the advertised 15 16 product or service. 17 (b) Done by any officer acting under the orders of any 18 court.
