HOUSE BILL NO. 1243

1 AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE RESIDENT INDIVIDUAL INCOME TAXPAYERS TO 2 DESIGNATE ANY PORTION OF THEIR TAX REFUND FOR A CONTRIBUTION TO BE 3 MADE TO THE STATE GENERAL FUND; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: **SECTION 1.** (1) Each resident individual taxpayer who files 5 a Mississippi income tax return and who will receive a tax refund from the Department of Revenue may designate that a contribution be made to the State General Fund by marking the appropriate box 8 9 printed on the return pursuant to this subsection. In the case of a joint return, each spouse may designate that a portion of the 10 11 refund shall be paid to such fund. The Department of Revenue shall print on the Mississippi 12 income tax form for residents a space for designating the 13 14 contribution in substantially the following form: "STATE GENERAL FUND 15 16 I wish to contribute () \$1 () \$5 () \$10 () Other \$ of my TAX REFUND TO THE STATE GENERAL FUND." 17

- 24 (4) The Department of Revenue shall determine annually the 25 total amount designated by individuals to be paid to the State 26 General Fund and shall report such amount to the State Treasurer 27 who shall pay such amount to State General Fund.
