HOUSE BILL NO. 1263

1 AN ACT TO ESTABLISH A COMMISSION TO REDESIGN THE MISSISSIPPI 2 STATE FLAG; TO PRESCRIBE THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE COMMISSION AND TO 3 PROVIDE FOR ITS ORGANIZATION AND MEETINGS; TO PROVIDE THAT THE 4 REDESIGNED MISSISSIPPI STATE FLAG ADOPTED BY THE COMMISSION SHALL 5 NOT INCLUDE THE DESIGN OF THE CONFEDERATE BATTLE FLAG; TO PROVIDE 6 THAT THE RECOMMENDATION OF THE COMMISSION SHALL BE PRESENTED TO 7 THE 2019 REGULAR SESSION OF THE LEGISLATURE; AND FOR RELATED 8 PURPOSES.

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 10 **SECTION 1.** (1) There is established the Commission to 11 Redesign the Mississippi State Flag (commission) with the sole 12 purpose of developing, designing and reporting to the Governor and 13 the Legislature a new design for the official Mississippi State 14 Flag on or before January 1, 2019. The new Mississippi State Flag 15 adopted by the commission shall not include the design of the Confederate Battle Flag. The commission is charged with a 16 sensitive and responsible task that it shall conduct in an 17 objective manner. The redesigned Mississippi State Flag shall 18 19 honor the past while embracing the promise of the future.

No. 1263 G1/2 18/HR43/R172 PAGE 1 (RF\EW) 20 (2)The Commission to Redesign the Mississippi State Flag 21 shall consist of seventeen (17) members, to be appointed as 22 follows: 23 Four (4) members of the Mississippi House of (a) 24 Representatives appointed by the Speaker of the House; 25 (b) Four (4) members of the Mississippi Senate appointed by the Lieutenant Governor; 26 27 Nine (9) members appointed by the Governor, to (C) 28 include: 29 (i) A Mississippi public schoolteacher and a 30 Mississippi public university instructor; 31 (ii) A representative from the Mississippi 32 Economic Council; 33 A representative from the Mississippi Arts (iii) Commission; 34 35 (iv) Two (2) representatives from the Board of 36 Trustees of the Mississippi Department of Archives and History; 37 A representative from business and industry; (V) 38 and 39 (vi) Two (2) members from the state at large. 40 All appointments shall be made not later than sixty (60) days after the effective date of this act. The chair of the commission 41 shall be appointed by the Governor from the members of the 42 43 commission. The commission shall meet as soon as practicable after appointments have been made upon the call of the chair, and 44

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45 shall organize for business. A quorum of the appointed membership 46 of the commission shall be required for the adoption of any 47 reports and recommendations. The Mississippi Department of 48 Archives and History shall provide meeting space and clerical 49 support for the operation of the commission.

50 (3) The Commission to Redesign the Mississippi State Flag 51 shall have the following functions and duties:

52 (a) To hold regular, public meetings when and where it 53 sees fit;

54 (b) To receive written, public comment, in a manner it 55 sees fit, and to hold public hearings, under the terms and 56 conditions it determines and sees fit;

57 (c) To collect, examine and consider all information 58 which it determines may be helpful in making a recommendation on 59 use and adoption of Mississippi's State Flag;

(d) To consult with historical experts, social science
experts, representatives of organizations and associations, and
others, as it sees fit, whose knowledge or expertise may assist
the commission in making its recommendation;

64 (e) To make any inquiries and conduct any business that
65 may assist the commission in submitting a design for a state flag;
66 however, the new Mississippi State Flag adopted by the commission
67 shall not include the design of the Confederate Battle Flag;

68 (f) Keep minutes of its meetings, and make those69 minutes available to the public; and

No. 1263 **~ OFFICIAL ~** 18/HR43/R172 PAGE 3 (RF\EW) 70 (a) To make a written recommendation for a new design 71 for the official Mississippi State Flag and an oral presentation 72 if requested, to the Governor, the Lieutenant Governor and the 73 Speaker of the House on or before January 1, 2019.

74 (4) Members of the commission shall receive no compensation 75 for service on the commission but may receive reimbursement for 76 mileage and actual expenses as provided in Section 25-3-41, to the 77 extent funds are available for that purpose.

78 The state flag currently in use shall remain in use (5) 79 until such time as the Mississippi Legislature considers the 80 report of the commission and the Legislature has had ample time to 81 act.

This act shall take effect and be in force from 82 SECTION 2. 83 and after its passage.
