HOUSE BILL NO. 1290

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 9-21-43, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO REQUIRE EACH CIRCUIT AND CHANCERY COURT TO REMIT FIFTEEN DOLLARS OF ANY MONIES IT COLLECTS FROM CRIMINAL OR CIVIL ACTIONS TO THE CIVIL LEGAL ASSISTANCE FUND; TO PROVIDE THAT THE MONIES SO REMITTED TO THE CIVIL LEGAL ASSISTANCE FUND SHALL BE ALLOCATED TO THE MISSISSIPPI CENTER FOR LEGAL SERVICES; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
SECTION 1. Section 9-21-43, Mississippi Code of 1972, is

10 amended as follows:

11 9-21-43. (1) There is hereby created in the State Treasury a special fund designated as the Civil Legal Assistance Fund. The 12 13 funds shall be administered by the Supreme Court through the 14 Administrative Office of Courts. The Administrative Office of 15 Courts may also accept monies from any public or private source 16 for deposit into the fund. Money remaining in the fund at the end 17 of a fiscal year shall not lapse into the State General Fund, and 18 any interest earned from the investment of monies in the fund shall be deposited to the credit of the * * * fund. 19

20 (2)All monies shall be allocated to only those 21 organizations providing legal services to low income 22 Mississippians. Furthermore, no monies from this fund shall be 23 expended to provide legal services in matters currently prohibited 24 by the Legal Services Corporation, Washington, D.C., and no funds 25 shall be expended on persons who are not financially eligible to 26 receive legal services as directed by the Legal Services 27 Corporation, Washington, D.C.

28 The monies appropriated shall be distributed to eligible (3)29 legal services programs based on the percentage of poverty 30 population within the program service area, consistent with the formula used by the Legal Services Corporation. 31

32 Monies appropriated to the fund may be used to promote (4) increased participation by the private bar in the delivery of 33 legal services to the indigent through the Mississippi Volunteer 34 35 Lawyers Project.

Recipients of funds shall have the following duties: 37 To develop, operate and administer programs within (a) 38 their respective service areas that provide free legal services to 39 indigent clients involved in civil matters;

40 (b) To report annually to the Supreme Court, through 41 the Administrative Office of Courts, on its activities, including 42 providing a copy of its annual audit that accounts for the use of 43 the funds; and

To refund annually all unused or uncommitted funds. (C)
