HOUSE BILL NO. 1295

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 25-3-31, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO INCREASE THE SALARY OF THE GOVERNOR, BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2020, TO 2 3 AN AMOUNT EQUAL TO FIFTY PERCENT OF THE SALARY OF THE PRESIDENT OF 4 THE UNITED STATES; TO INCREASE THE SALARIES OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL, SECRETARY OF STATE, COMMISSIONER OF INSURANCE, STATE 5 6 TREASURER, STATE AUDITOR OF PUBLIC ACCOUNTS AND COMMISSIONER OF AGRICULTURE AND COMMERCE, BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2020, TO AN AMOUNT 7 EQUAL TO SIXTY PERCENT OF THE SALARY OF THE GOVERNOR OF THE STATE 8 9 OF MISSISSIPPI; TO INCREASE THE SALARIES OF THE TRANSPORTATION 10 COMMISSIONERS AND PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSIONERS, BEGINNING JANUARY 11 1, 2020, TO AN AMOUNT EQUAL TO FIFTY PERCENT OF THE SALARY OF THE 12 GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI; TO AMEND SECTION 5-1-43, 13 MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO INCREASE THE SALARIES OF THE LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR AND SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, 14 15 BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2020, TO AN AMOUNT EQUAL TO SIXTY PERCENT OF 16 THE SALARY OF THE GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI; TO AMEND 17 SECTION 5-1-41, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO INCREASE THE SALARY 18 OF EACH SENATOR AND REPRESENTATIVE, BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2020, TO AN AMOUNT EQUAL TO FIFTEEN PERCENT OF THE SALARY OF THE GOVERNOR 19 20 OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

increased during their term of office. Whenever the annual salary of the President of the United States is increased, the salary for each officer established in subsection (1) shall be increased accordingly on the first day of the next succeeding term of

82 SECTION 2. Section 5-1-43, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 83 amended as follows:

#### 84 [Until January 1, 2020, this section shall read as follows:]

5-1-43. (1) The salary of the Lieutenant Governor and of the Speaker of the House of Representatives shall be Sixty Thousand Dollars (\$60,000.00) annually, and they shall receive for attending each extraordinary or called session the same compensation and mileage as is provided for members of the Legislature. **\* \* \*** 

91 (2) On the first day of each month, the Lieutenant Governor 92 and the Speaker of the House of Representatives shall receive in 93 twelve (12) equal monthly installments the compensation provided 94 for pursuant to subsection (1) of this section.

#### [Until January 1, 2020, this section shall read as follows:]

112 5-1-41. Beginning with the 1986 Regular Session of the Legislature of the State of Mississippi, each Senator and 113 114 Representative of the Legislature shall receive as compensation at each regular session the sum of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00) 115 and the mileage allowance provided by Section 25-3-41, for each 116 117 mile of the distance by the most direct route usually traveled in 118 coming to and returning from the place where the Legislature sits. Beginning on April 16, 1997, each Senator and Representative shall 119 120 receive for attending each extraordinary session or called session 121 the sum of Seventy-five Dollars (\$75.00) per day and mileage at 122 the same rate as per regular session. In addition to the above, beginning on April 16, 1997, each Senator and Representative and 123 124 the Lieutenant Governor shall receive the sum of One Thousand Five 125 Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00) per month for expenses incidental to 126 his office for every full month of his term, except any month or

134 5-1-41. \* \* \* Each Senator and Representative of the 135 Legislature shall receive as compensation \* \* \* an amount equal to 136 fifteen percent (15%) of the annual salary of the Governor of the 137 State of Mississippi as established in Section 25-3-31 and the 138 mileage allowance provided by Section 25-3-41, for each mile of 139 the distance by the most direct route usually traveled in coming 140 to and returning from the place where the Legislature sits. \* \* \* Each Senator and Representative shall receive for attending each 141 142 extraordinary session or called session the sum of Seventy-five 143 Dollars (\$75.00) per day and mileage at the same rate as per regular session. In addition to the above, \* \* \* each Senator and 144 Representative and the Lieutenant Governor shall receive the sum 145 146 of One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00) per month for 147 expenses incidental to his or her office for every full month of 148 his or her term, except any month or major fraction thereof when 149 the Legislature is convened in regular or extraordinary session; 150 and payments shall be made to each Senator and Representative and 151 the Lieutenant Governor by the State Treasurer between the first
