236	(9) If a fine or other penalty imposed is suspended, in
237	whole or in part, such suspension shall not affect the state
238	assessment under this section. No state assessment imposed under
239	the provisions of this section may be suspended or reduced by the
240	court.
241	(10) (a) After a determination by the court of the amount
242	due, it shall be the duty of the clerk of the court to promptly
243	collect all state assessments imposed under the provisions of this

section. The state assessments imposed under the provisions of this section may not be paid by personal check.

- 246 It shall be the duty of the chancery clerk of each county to deposit all state assessments collected in the circuit, 247 248 county and justice courts in the county on a monthly basis with 249 the State Treasurer pursuant to appropriate procedures established 250 by the State Auditor. The chancery clerk shall make a monthly 251 lump-sum deposit of the total state assessments collected in the 252 circuit, county and justice courts in the county under this 253 section, and shall report to the Department of Finance and 254 Administration the total number of violations under each 255 subsection for which state assessments were collected in the 256 circuit, county and justice courts in the county during that 257 month.
- 258 It shall be the duty of the municipal clerk of each 259 municipality to deposit all the state assessments collected in the 260 municipal court in the municipality on a monthly basis with the 261 State Treasurer pursuant to appropriate procedures established by 262 the State Auditor. The municipal clerk shall make a monthly 263 lump-sum deposit of the total state assessments collected in the 264 municipal court in the municipality under this section, and shall 265 report to the Department of Finance and Administration the total 266 number of violations under each subsection for which state 267 assessments were collected in the municipal court in the 268 municipality during that month.

269	(11) It shall be the duty of the Department of Finance and
270	Administration to deposit on a monthly basis all state assessments
271	into the State General Fund or proper special fund in the State
272	Treasury. The Department of Finance and Administration shall
273	issue regulations providing for the proper allocation of these
274	funds.

- (12) The State Auditor shall establish by regulation procedures for refunds of state assessments, including refunds associated with assessments imposed before July 1, 1990, and refunds after appeals in which the defendant's conviction is reversed. The Auditor shall provide in the regulations for certification of eligibility for refunds and may require the defendant seeking a refund to submit a verified copy of a court order or abstract by which the defendant is entitled to a refund. All refunds of state assessments shall be made in accordance with the procedures established by the Auditor.
- **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 286 and after July 1, 2018.
