## HOUSE BILL NO. 1322

- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 37-41-1, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO REQUIRE EACH SCHOOL BUS PURCHASED BY A LOCAL SCHOOL BOARD TO BE EQUIPPED WITH SEAT BELTS AT ALL SEATING POSITIONS; TO REQUIRE THE STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION TO PROMULGATE RULES REGARDING THE TYPES OF SEAT BELTS REQUIRED AND USE OF SEAT BELTS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 8 **SECTION 1.** Each school bus purchased by a local school board
- 9 under the authority granted by Section 37-41-81 after July 1,
- 10 2018, shall be equipped with seat belts at all seating positions.
- SECTION 2. Section 37-41-1, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 12 amended as follows:
- 13 37-41-1. The State Board of Education is authorized,
- 14 empowered and directed to promulgate rules and regulations
- 15 relating to the transportation of students enrolled in the public
- 16 school districts, including rules and regulations for:

- 42 All rules and regulations adopted and promulgated by the
- State Board of Education relating to school district bus drivers 43

- 47 State Board of Education pursuant to the authority conferred by
- 48 this section shall be spread at large upon the minutes of the

- 51 effective date of such rules and regulations.
- 52 The provisions of this chapter are applicable to school
- 53 districts and the transportation of students enrolled in public
- 54 school districts. Charter schools authorized by the Mississippi
- 55 Charter School Authorizer Board are exempt from the provisions of
- 56 this chapter.
- 57 **SECTION 3.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 58 and after July 1, 2018.
