HOUSE BILL NO. 1327

AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT WHEN A MENTALLY ILL INMATE ESCAPES A CORRECTIONAL FACILITY, OR A PATIENT ESCAPES A MENTAL HEALTH TREATMENT FACILITY, THE PUBLIC SHALL BE NOTIFIED OF THE MENTAL ILLNESS; TO DEFINE THE TERM "MENTAL ILLNESS"; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 7 **SECTION 1.** Notwithstanding any provision of the federal
- 8 Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPAA), when
- 9 an inmate escapes from any municipal, county or state correctional
- 10 facility or when a patient escapes a mental health treatment
- 11 facility, a designated law enforcement official shall include in
- 12 the notification to the public, regarding the escape: (i) whether
- 13 the inmate has been treated or is currently being treated for
- 14 mental illness and (ii) whether such inmate may be a danger to the
- 15 safety of the public due to the mental illness. As used in this
- 16 section, "mental illness" shall have the same meaning as the term
- 17 is defined in Section 41-21-61.
- 18 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 19 and after July 1, 2018.
