HOUSE BILL NO. 1333 (As Sent to Governor)

1 AN ACT TO CREATE THE MISSISSIPPI HONEY PRODUCERS ADVISORY 2 COUNCIL; TO PROVIDE FOR A REVIEW BY THE ADVISORY COUNCIL OF THE 3 LAWS REGULATING THE PRODUCTION OF HONEY IN MISSISSIPPI; TO PROVIDE 4 FOR THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE MISSISSIPPI HONEY PRODUCERS ADVISORY 5 COUNCIL; TO REQUIRE THAT THE COUNCIL REPORT ITS FINDINGS AND 6 RECOMMENDED AMENDMENTS, IF ANY, TO THE LEGISLATURE NO LATER THAN 7 NOVEMBER 30, 2018; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 9 **SECTION 1.** (1) There is created the Mississippi Honey Producers Advisory Council. The purpose of the advisory council 10 11 is to review the laws and regulations governing the production of honey in Mississippi to determine if those laws and regulations 12 13 address the concerns of the industry or if those laws and regulations need revision to address the concerns of the industry, 14 15 and to prepare and develop its findings and recommendations in a 16 written report to the Legislature.

17 (2) The Mississippi Honey Producers Advisory Council shall
18 be composed of ten (10) members of the Executive Board of the
19 Mississippi Beekeepers Association. There shall be two (2) staff
20 members from the Mississippi Department of Agriculture and

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22 Department of Health, and one (1) staff member from Mississippi
23 State University Extension Service at each meeting of the advisory
24 council to provide technical assistance. The council may seek
25 input from all of the aforementioned state agencies.

26 (3) The president of the association shall be the chair of 27 the Mississippi Honey Producers Advisory Council. The chair shall 28 be responsible for calling meetings of the council and conducting 29 the meetings. The council shall elect a vice chair to serve as 30 secretary who shall be responsible for keeping all records and minutes of the advisory council. All members shall be notified in 31 32 writing of all meetings; such notices shall be mailed or emailed, as determined by the council, at least fifteen (15) days before 33 34 the date on which a meeting is to be held. Members of the 35 advisory council shall not be compensated or reimbursed for travel 36 expenses. Notice of meetings of the advisory council shall be 37 provided to the Chairman of the Senate Agriculture Committee, the Chairman of the House Agriculture Committee, and the state 38 39 agencies and institutions referenced in subsection (2) of this 40 section at least fifteen (15) days prior to said meeting.

(4) Meetings shall be conducted at either the Mississippi
Department of Agriculture and Commerce or the Mississippi State
Department of Health, depending on meeting space availability.
The agencies are directed to work with the chair to provide

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45 meeting space. The advisory council shall meet and organize 46 thirty (30) days after the passage of this act.

47 (5) A majority of the members of the advisory council shall 48 constitute a quorum. In the selection of the vice chair, and the 49 adoption of rules, minutes, findings and recommendations, an 50 affirmative vote of a majority of the advisory council shall be 51 required.

No later than November 30, 2018, the council shall 52 (6) 53 report its findings and recommendation in writing to the Chairman 54 of the Senate Agriculture Committee and the Chairman of the House 55 Agriculture Committee. After submitting the recommendation and 56 findings required in subsection (1) of this section, the 57 Mississippi Honey Producers Advisory Council shall be dissolved. 58 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 59 and after its passage.
