## HOUSE BILL NO. 1381

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 3-3-15, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO

2 REQUIRE PUBLIC COLLEGES AND UNIVERSITIES TO DISPLAY THE OFFICIAL STATE FLAG ON MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY OF EACH WEEK ON EACH CAMPUS OF THE PUBLIC COLLEGE OR UNIVERSITY; TO REQUIRE THAT IF A PUBLIC 5 COLLEGE OR UNIVERSITY IS NOT DISPLAYING THE OFFICIAL STATE FLAG AS REQUIRED BY THIS SECTION, THE ATTORNEY GENERAL SHALL NOTIFY THE 7 PUBLIC COLLEGE OR UNIVERSITY OF THE NONCOMPLIANCE, AND THE STATE 8 FISCAL OFFICER SHALL WITHHOLD THE PAYMENT OF ALL STATE FUNDS TO 9 THE PUBLIC COLLEGE OR UNIVERSITY UNTIL SUCH TIME AS IT IS IN 10 COMPLIANCE WITH THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SECTION; AND FOR RELATED 11 PURPOSES. 12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 13 SECTION 1. Section 3-3-15, Mississippi Code of 1972, is amended as follows: 14 15 3-3-15. (1) The official state flag may be displayed from all public buildings from sunrise to sunset, and shall be 16 17 displayed on Monday through Friday of each week from sunrise to 18 sunset on each campus of each public college or university. However, the state flag may be displayed from all public buildings 19 20 and on public college or university campuses twenty-four (24)

hours a day if properly illuminated. The state flag should not be

displayed when the weather is inclement, except when an

- otherwise has knowledge that a public college or university is not 29

55	as it is in compliance with the requirements of subsection (1) of

57	SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
