HOUSE BILL NO. 1575

1 AN ACT APPROVING THE EXPENDITURE OF SPECIAL FUNDS FOR THE 2 PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING THE EXPENSES OF THE MISSISSIPPI STATE BOARD 3 OF PSYCHOLOGY FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2019. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 5 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 6 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 7 Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi State Board of Psychology, for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the board 8 9 for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2018, and ending 10 June 30, 2019.....\$ 124,837.00. 11 SECTION 2. It is the intention of the Legislature that the Mississippi State Board of Psychology shall maintain complete 12 13 accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all 14 funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal 15 16 Year 2018. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2020 shall be 17 18 submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format

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19 and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail 20 provided during the Fiscal Year 2019 budget request process.

21 SECTION 3. It is the intention of the Legislature that 22 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the 23 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things 24 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind 25 26 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to 27 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are 28 made without competitive bids.

SECTION 4. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of this act, an amount not to exceed Eighty Thousand Two Hundred Sixty-eight Dollars (\$80,268.00) shall be expended for professional board management fees.

33 SECTION 5. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 34 funds herein appropriated shall be expended in compliance with 35 Section 27-104-25, Mississippi Code of 1972, that no state agency 36 shall incur obligations or indebtedness in excess of their 37 appropriation and that the responsible officers, either personally 38 or upon their official bonds, shall be held responsible for 39 actions contrary to this provision.

40 **SECTION 6.** The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 41 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 42 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 43 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal

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44 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 45 46 SECTION 7. It is the intention of the Legislature that this agency shall have the authority to expend funds from any source 47 48 that may become available to the agency in accordance with the 49 rules and regulations of the Department of Finance and 50 Administration in a manner consistent with the escalation of 51 federal funds for the purpose of funding any increase in health 52 insurance costs for Fiscal Year 2019, or for the purpose of 53 funding additional fees, costs or assessments received by the 54 agency from the Department of Information Technology Services or 55 the Department of Finance and Administration for Fiscal Year 2019 56 that may be incurred by the agency as a result of legislation 57 passed during the 2018 Regular Session of the Legislature and approved by the Governor. The agency is authorized to escalate 58 59 other special funds for the limited purposes provided in this 60 section in an amount not to exceed Seven Thousand Six Hundred Seventy-one Dollars (\$7,671.00). 61

62 SECTION 8. This act shall take effect and be in force from 63 and after July 1, 2018.
