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18 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 19 the terms, conditions, and procedures established by law.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

24 SECTION 3. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 25 Office of Capital Post-Conviction Counsel shall maintain complete 26 accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all 27 funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal 28 29 Year 2018. It is further the intention of the Legislature that 30 the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2020 shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format 31 32 and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail 33 provided during the Fiscal Year 2019 budget request process.

34 SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the 35 36 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things 37 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, 38 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind 39 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to 40 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are made without competitive bids. 41

It is the intention of the Legislature that the 43 funds herein appropriated shall be expended in compliance with 44 Section 27-104-25, Mississippi Code of 1972, that no state agency 45 shall incur obligations or indebtedness in excess of their 46 appropriation and that the responsible officers, either personally 47 or upon their official bonds, shall be held responsible for 48 actions contrary to this provision.

49 **SECTION 6.** The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 50 necessary, is reappropriated out of any money in the General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the Office of Capital 51 52 Post-Conviction Counsel for the purpose of reauthorizing the 53 expenditure of General Funds for agency operations, as authorized 54 in HB 1496, 2017 Regular Session, for the fiscal year beginning 55 July 1, 2018, and ending June 30, 2019.....\$ 100,000.00. 56 Notwithstanding the amount reappropriated under the 57 provisions of this section, in no event shall the amount expended

58 exceed the unexpended balance of June 30, 2018.

59 SECTION 7. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 60 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 61 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 62 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 63 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 64 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 65 SECTION 8. This act shall take effect and be in force from

66 and after July 1, 2018.

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
