HOUSE BILL NO. 1594 (As Sent to Governor)

1 AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE SUPPORT AND 2 MAINTENANCE OF THE MISSISSIPPI LIBRARY COMMISSION FOR THE FISCAL 3 YEAR 2019. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 5 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 6 necessary, is appropriated out of any money in the State General 7 Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the support and maintenance of the Mississippi Library Commission and for carrying out the 8 9 provisions of Section 39-3-107, Mississippi Code of 1972, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2018, and ending June 30, 2019 10 11\$ 9,328,593.00. 12 SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 13 necessary, is appropriated out of any money in the special fund in 14 the State Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi Library Commission which is comprised of special source funds collected by 15 16 or otherwise available to the commission, for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the commission for the fiscal year 17 18 beginning July 1, 2018, and ending June 30, 2019.....

20 SECTION 3. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
21 this act, the following positions are authorized:

27 With the funds herein appropriated, it shall be the agency's 28 responsibility to make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal Services" for Fiscal Year 2020 do not 29 30 exceed Fiscal Year 2019 funds appropriated for that purpose, 31 unless programs or positions are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 32 2019 budget by the Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel 33 34 Board shall determine and publish the projected annual cost to 35 fully fund all appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this act. It shall be the responsibility of the 36 37 agency head to ensure that no single personnel action increases 38 this projected annual cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2019 39 appropriations for "Personal Services" when annualized, with the 40 exception of escalated funds and the award of benchmarks. If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal 41 42 Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this 43

No. 1594 **~ OFFICIAL ~** 18/HR31/A245SG PAGE 2 44 projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2019 "Personal Services" 45 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 46 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation 47 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 48 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.

49 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or 50 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State 51 52 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written 53 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The 54 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written 55 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions 56 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the 57 appropriated level.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

None of the funds herein appropriated shall be used in violation of Internal Revenue Service's Publication 15-A relating to the reporting of income paid to contract employees, as interpreted by the Office of the State Auditor.

Funds to be distributed to eligible public library systemsunder the Personnel Incentive Grants Program shall be paid

68 quarterly in advance on or before September 30, December 31, March 69 31 and June 30.

70 It is the intention of the Legislature that the SECTION 4. 71 Mississippi Library Commission shall maintain complete accounting 72 and personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds 73 appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the 74 same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year 2018. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the 75 76 agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2020 shall be submitted to 77 the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of 78 detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided 79 during the Fiscal Year 2019 budget request process.

80 SECTION 5. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of 81 Section 2, Four Hundred Ninety-three Thousand Eight Hundred 82 Forty-seven Dollars (\$493,847.00) shall be derived from the 83 Education Enhancement Fund deposited pursuant to Sections 27-65-75 84 and 27-67-31, Mississippi Code of 1972.

85 SECTION 6. In compliance with the "Mississippi Performance 86 Budget and Strategic Planning Act of 1994," it is the intent of 87 the Legislature that the funds provided herein shall be utilized 88 in the most efficient and effective manner possible to achieve the 89 intended mission of this agency. Based on the funding authorized, 90 this agency shall make every effort to attain the targeted

121 **SECTION 7.** It is the intention of the Legislature that no 122 less than One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) shall be expended 123 for the Magnolia Database.

SECTION 8. Of the funds appropriated herein, Three Million Five Hundred One Thousand Nine Hundred Thirty-two Dollars (\$3,501,932.00) is provided for the cost of health insurance for all full-time library staff members in each public library in Mississippi.

It is the intention of the Legislature that 129 SECTION 9. 130 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things 131 132 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, 133 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind 134 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to 135 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are 136 made without competitive bids.

137 SECTION 10. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 138 funds herein appropriated shall be expended in compliance with 139 Section 27-104-25, Mississippi Code of 1972, that no state agency 140 shall incur obligations or indebtedness in excess of their 141 appropriation and that the responsible officers, either personally

144 **SECTION 11.** The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 145 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 146 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 147 148 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 149 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 150 SECTION 12. This act shall take effect and be in force from 151 and after July 1, 2018.
