HOUSE BILL NO. 1596 (As Sent to Governor)

1 AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING 2 THE EXPENSES OF THE DEPARTMENT OF ARCHIVES AND HISTORY, FOR THE 3 FISCAL YEAR 2019. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 5 6 necessary, is appropriated out of any money in the State General 7 Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the Department of Archives and History for the fiscal 8 9 year beginning July 1, 2018, and ending June 30, 2019.....\$ 9,535,631.00. 10 11 SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 12 necessary, is appropriated out of any money in the special fund in 13 the State Treasury to the credit of the Department of Archives and 14 History which is comprised of special source funds collected by or 15 otherwise available to the department, for the purpose of 16 defraying the expenses of the department for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2018, and ending June 30, 2019..... 17\$ 8,537,020.00. 18

26 With the funds herein appropriated, it shall be the agency's 27 responsibility to make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal Services" for Fiscal Year 2020 do not 28 29 exceed Fiscal Year 2019 funds appropriated for that purpose, 30 unless programs or positions are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 31 2019 budget by the Mississippi Legislature. Based on data 32 provided by the Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel 33 Board shall determine and publish the projected annual cost to 34 fully fund all appropriated positions in compliance with the 35 provisions of this act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to ensure that no single personnel action increases 36 37 this projected annual cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2019 38 appropriations for "Personal Services" when annualized, with the 39 exception of escalated funds and the award of benchmarks. If, at 40 the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency 41 42 has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2019 "Personal Services" 43

44 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 45 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation 46 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 47 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.

48 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 49 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or 50 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State 51 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written 52 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written 53 54 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions 55 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the 56 appropriated level.

57 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be 58 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are 59 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this 60 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

None of the funds herein appropriated shall be used in violation of Internal Revenue Service's Publication 15-A relating to the reporting of income paid to contract employees, as interpreted by the Office of the State Auditor.

65 SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 66 Department of Archives and History shall maintain complete 67 accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all 68 funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be

It is further the intention of the Legislature that 71 the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2020 shall be 72 submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format 73 and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail 74 provided during the Fiscal Year 2019 budget request process.

75 SECTION 5. It is the intent of the Legislature that the 76 Mississippi Department of Archives and History shall charge the 77 maximum amount allowable for services rendered, consistent with 78 the cost of providing such services. The funds derived from these 79 charges shall be deposited into a special fund account in the 80 State Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi Department of 81 Archives and History.

82 SECTION 6. It is the intent of the Legislature that no part 83 of the funds herein appropriated shall be required to be used for 84 the payment of rent for the museum and public space in the State 85 Historical Museum, Old Capitol Restoration.

86 SECTION 7. Of the funds provided in Section 2, Two Million 87 Dollars (\$2,000,000.00) is provided to the Department of Archives 88 and History from the Mississippi Landmark Grant Fund as created in 89 House Bill No. 1082, Regular Session of 1999, to help support the 90 preservation of Mississippi Landmark Properties.

91 **SECTION 8.** Of the funds provided under the provisions of 92 this act, One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00) is provided 93 for the purpose of capital development and maintenance of Beauvoir

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94 Shrine, the last home of Jefferson Davis, the only President of 95 the Confederate States of America, subject to approval by the 96 Department of Archives and History. The expenditure of funds 97 available in this section shall be subject to prior approval by 98 the Department of Archives and History.

99 SECTION 9. It is the intention of the Legislature that 100 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the 101 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things 102 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, 103 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind 104 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to 105 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are 106 made without competitive bids.

107 SECTION 10. In addition to all other sums herein 108 appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be 109 necessary, is appropriated out of any money in the State General 110 Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the Department of Archives and History for the purpose of supporting the Statewide Oral History 111 112 Project for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2018, and ending 113 June 30, 2019.....\$ 45,748.00.

SECTION 11. It is the intention of the Legislature that the funds herein appropriated shall be expended in compliance with Section 27-104-25, Mississippi Code of 1972, that no state agency shall incur obligations or indebtedness in excess of their appropriation and that the responsible officers, either personally

SECTION 12. Of the funds appropriated in Section 2, Fifty-one Thousand Dollars (\$51,000.00) from the Historic Properties Trust Fund is provided for the study of expanding areas of Vicksburg National Military Park.

125 SECTION 13. Of the funds provided in Section 2, Seven 126 Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$750,000.00) is provided from 127 Special Funds in the State Treasury to the credit of the State Treasury fund created in Section 27-19-56.69(8), Mississippi Code 128 129 of 1972, for the purpose of paying the costs of repair and 130 renovation of the New Capitol, the Old Capitol, the Governor's 131 Mansion, and the War Memorial Building, in accordance with rules 132 and regulations of the Department of Finance and Administration in 133 a manner consistent with the escalation of funds.

134 SECTION 14. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 135 necessary, is reappropriated out of any money in the State General 136 Fund not otherwise appropriated for the Department of Archives and 137 History for the purpose of reauthorizing the expenditure of One 138 Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00) in State General Funds, as 139 authorized in HB 1506, 2017 Regular Session and Thirty-one 140 Thousand One Hundred Seventy-six Dollars (\$31,176.00) in State General Funds as authorized in HB 1506, 2017 Regular Session to 141 provide for capital development and maintenance of the Beauvoir 142

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143 Shrine, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2018, and ending June 30, 2019.....\$ 144 131,176.00. 145 SECTION 15. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 146 necessary, is reappropriated out of any money in the Capital 147 Expense Fund not otherwise appropriated for the Department of 148 Archives and History for the purpose of reauthorizing the expenditure of Capital Expense Fund, as authorized in HB 1506, 149 2017 Regular Session to provide for the Old Smith County Jailhouse 150 for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2018, and ending June 30, 151 152 2019.....\$ 130,000.00. 153 **SECTION 16.** The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 154 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 155 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 156 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 157 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 158 159 SECTION 17. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after July 1, 2018. 160
