1 AN ACT APPROVING THE EXPENDITURE OF SPECIAL FUNDS FOR THE 2 PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING THE EXPENSES OF THE PEARL RIVER VALLEY WATER 3 SUPPLY DISTRICT FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2019. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 4 5 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is authorized and approved for expenditure out of any 6 funds which are received by or otherwise become available to the 7 8 Pearl River Valley Water Supply District, for the purpose of 9 defraying the expenses of the district for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2018, and ending June 30, 2019..... 10 11 .....\$ 18,209,440.00. 12 SECTION 2. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of Section 1, the following positions are authorized: 13 14 AUTHORIZED POSITIONS: Permanent: Full Time..... 119 15 Part Time..... 16 0 Time-Limited: Full Time..... 17 2 18 Part Time.... 0

19 With the funds herein appropriated, it shall be the agency's 20 responsibility to make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal Services" for Fiscal Year 2020 do not 21 22 exceed Fiscal Year 2019 funds appropriated for that purpose, 23 unless programs or positions are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 24 2019 budget by the Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel 25 26 Board shall determine and publish the projected annual cost to 27 fully fund all appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this act. It shall be the responsibility of the 28 29 agency head to ensure that no single personnel action increases 30 this projected annual cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2019 appropriations for "Personal Services" when annualized, with the 31 32 exception of escalated funds and the award of benchmarks. If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal 33 34 Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency 35 has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2019 "Personal Services" 36 37 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 38 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation 39 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 40 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.

Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State

44 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written 45 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The 46 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written 47 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions 48 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the 49 appropriated level.

50 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be 51 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are 52 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this 53 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

None of the funds herein appropriated shall be used in violation of Internal Revenue Service's Publication 15-A relating to the reporting of income paid to contract employees, as interpreted by the Office of the State Auditor.

58 SECTION 3. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 59 Pearl River Valley Water Supply District shall maintain complete 60 accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be 61 62 in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal 63 Year 2018. It is further the intention of the Legislature that 64 the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2020 shall be 65 submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail 66 67 provided during the Fiscal Year 2019 budget request process.

It is the intention of the Legislature that 69 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the 70 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things 71 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, 72 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind 73 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to 74 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are 75 made without competitive bids.

SECTION 5. The funds herein approved for expenditure, except and less an amount approved by the State Fiscal Officer which shall be sufficient to cover disbursements for current operations, shall be deposited at interest with any official depository of the state at a rate of interest numerically not less than one percent (1%) below the bank discount rate on United States Treasury bills of comparable maturity as determined by the State Treasurer.

83 SECTION 6. None of the funds appropriated for expenditure 84 under this act may be expended by Pearl River Valley Water Supply District until the district agrees to comply with the following 85 86 conditions: (1) If any local governmental or nonprofit entity 87 wins the bid for the ESPN Bass Masters Classic or the FLW Major 88 Open, these events shall be exempt from the district's lottery 89 system for host events at the reservoir and given priority of any 90 and all date options available. (2) If any local governmental or 91 nonprofit entity wins the bid for such events, the district shall waive the daily launch fees or any other special event fees for 92

93 the ESPN Bass Masters Classic or the FLW Major Open. (3) The 94 Catch A Dream Foundation Bass Classic shall be held on the first 95 Sunday in May unless any local governmental or nonprofit entity 96 wins the bid for the ESPN Bass Masters Classic or the FLW Major 97 Open on that date. The Catch A Dream Foundation Bass Classic 98 shall be exempt from the district's lottery system for host events 99 at the reservoir and given priority for the first Sunday in May. 100 The district shall waive the daily launch fees or any other 101 special event fees for the Classic.

102 **SECTION 7.** Of the funds appropriated herein, Two Hundred 103 Thousand Dollars (\$200,000.00) is provided for salary increase for 104 the purpose of funding overtime, callback or standby pay.

105 SECTION 8. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 106 funds herein appropriated shall be expended in compliance with 107 Section 27-104-25, Mississippi Code of 1972, that no state agency 108 shall incur obligations or indebtedness in excess of their 109 appropriation and that the responsible officers, either personally 110 or upon their official bonds, shall be held responsible for 111 actions contrary to this provision.

112 SECTION 9. The money herein approved for expenditure shall 113 be disbursed upon bank checks signed by the proper person, officer 114 or officers, in the manner provided by law or in accordance with 115 the provisions of a valid trust indenture.

SECTION 10. It is the intention of the Legislature that this agency shall have the authority to expend funds from any source

118 that may become available to the agency in accordance with the 119 rules and regulations of the Department of Finance and 120 Administration in a manner consistent with the escalation of 121 federal funds for the purpose of funding any increase in health insurance costs for Fiscal Year 2019, or for the purpose of 122 123 funding additional fees, costs or assessments received by the 124 agency from the Department of Information Technology Services or the Department of Finance and Administration for Fiscal Year 2019 125 126 that may be incurred by the agency as a result of legislation passed during the 2018 Regular Session of the Legislature and 127 128 approved by the Governor. The agency is authorized to escalate 129 other special funds for the limited purposes provided in this 130 section in an amount not to exceed Thirteen Thousand Sixty-eight 131 Dollars (\$13,068.00).

132 SECTION 11. This act shall take effect and be in force from 133 and after July 1, 2018.
