## HOUSE BILL NO. 1620

- AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE GOVERNING AUTHORITIES OF THE CITY OF FULTON, MISSISSIPPI, TO EXPAND ITS WATER DISTRIBUTION SYSTEM
  WITHIN A CERTAIN DISTANCE OUTSIDE THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF FULTON; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 6 **SECTION 1.** (1) Notwithstanding any provisions of Section
- 7 21-27-39, Mississippi Code of 1972, to the contrary, the governing
- 8 authorities of the City of Fulton, Mississippi, may, in their
- 9 discretion, construct, expand, operate and maintain its water
- 10 system of the City of Fulton for a distance not to exceed fifteen
- 11 (15) miles from the corporate limits of the City of Fulton.
- 12 Whenever water services are furnished to any customer residing
- 13 outside the corporate limits of the City of Fulton, the consumer
- 14 may not be charged at a rate greater than twice the rate charged
- 15 for the same service within the corporate limits of the City of
- 16 Fulton.
- 17 (2) The authority conferred by this act shall not be
- 18 construed as an exemption from the provisions of Section 77-3-1 et
- 19 seq., Mississippi Code of 1972, as to the requirements for

- 20 obtaining a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity, the
- 21 jurisdiction of the Public Service Commission to regulate rates or
- 22 any other provisions of that law.
- 23 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 24 and after its passage.
