HOUSE BILL NO. 1682

- AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE GOVERNING AUTHORITIES OF THE CITY OF CRYSTAL SPRINGS, MISSISSIPPI, TO ALLOW THE OPERATION OF GOLF CARTS AND LOW-SPEED VEHICLES ON CERTAIN PUBLIC ROADS AND STREETS WITHIN THE CITY; TO REQUIRE ANY INDIVIDUAL OPERATING A GOLF CART OR LOW-SPEED VEHICLE ON SUCH PUBLIC ROADS AND STREETS TO HAVE A VALID DRIVER'S LICENSE OR TEMPORARY DRIVER'S PERMIT; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 9 **SECTION 1.** As used in this act, unless a different meaning
- 10 clearly appears in the context, the following terms shall have the
- 11 following meanings:
- 12 (a) "City" means the City of Crystal Springs,
- 13 Mississippi.
- 14 (b) "Governing authorities" means the Board of Aldermen
- 15 of the City of Crystal Springs, Mississippi.
- 16 (c) "Golf Cart" means a motor vehicle that is
- 17 designated and manufactured for operation on a golf course for
- 18 sporting or recreational purposes and that is not capable of
- 19 exceeding speeds of twenty-five (25) miles per hour and is

- 20 equipped with a parking brake, head lamps, tail lamps, seat belts,
- 21 and front and rear turn signals.
- 22 (d) "Low-speed vehicle" means any four-wheeled electric
- 23 or gasoline powered vehicle that has a top speed greater than
- 24 twenty (20) miles per hour but less than twenty-five (25) miles
- 25 per hour and is equipped with safety equipment as required under
- 26 49 CFR Section 571.500.
- 27 **SECTION 2.** (1) The governing authorities of the City of
- 28 Crystal Springs, Mississippi, may, in their discretion, authorize
- 29 the operation of golf carts and/or low-speed vehicles only on
- 30 public roads and streets as designated by ordinance, within the
- 31 city limits of the City of Crystal Springs, Mississippi. The
- 32 authorization must be embodied in an ordinance and recorded on the
- 33 minutes of the board of aldermen. Such authorization may be
- 34 accompanied by conditions not inconsistent with this act and may
- 35 be revoked, in whole or in part, by the governing authorities at
- 36 any time.
- 37 (2) Any person operating a golf cart or low-speed vehicle on
- 38 the public roads and streets under this act must have in his or
- 39 her possession a valid driver's license or temporary driver's
- 40 permit and proof of financial responsibility as required under
- 41 Section 63-51-1 et seq., Mississippi Code of 1972.
- 42 (3) Golf carts and low-speed vehicles may not be operated on
- 43 interstate highways, U.S. highways, or state highways in the city,
- 44 except for the crossing of these streets, in which case the

- 45 shortest traveling distance to do so shall be required. Drivers
- 46 are required to operate golf carts and low-speed vehicles only in
- 47 the outside lane of multi-lane streets and roads, when applicable.
- 48 **SECTION 3.** The governing authorities may, pursuant to
- 49 ordinance, require registration of golf carts and/or low-speed
- 50 vehicles with costs to be determined.
- 51 **SECTION 4.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 52 and after its passage.
