HOUSE BILL NO. 1695

1 AN ACT TO RESTORE THE RIGHT OF SUFFRAGE TO CATINA FAULKNER  
2 TAYLOR, OF MARSHALL COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

4 **SECTION 1.** The right of suffrage is hereby fully and  
5 completely restored to Catina Faulkner Taylor, of Marshall County,  
6 Mississippi, who was disqualified as an elector as a result of her  
7 conviction on January 22, 1999, of two (2) counts for the crime of  
8 Uttering Forgery in Marshall County, Mississippi, and who was  
9 sentenced to serve two (2) years in the custody of the Department  
10 of Corrections with three (3) years probation. During her release  
11 from the Intensive Supervision program, she violated the terms of  
12 her release and was sentenced on August 22, 2001, in Marshall  
13 County to the custody of the Department of Corrections of two (2)  
14 counts of Uttering Forgery, and sentenced to five (5) years for  
15 four (4) counts of Uttering Forgery. On April 3, 2002, she was  
16 sentenced to serve two (2) years in the custody of the Department  
17 of Corrections for the crime of identity theft, and sentenced to  
18 serve one (1) year with two years probation. She completed all



19 terms and conditions of her sentence on March 14, 2013. The  
20 Legislature is informed that she has since conducted herself as a  
21 law-abiding and honorable citizen in a good and lawful manner.

22       **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from  
23 and after its passage.
