HOUSE BILL NO. 1701

AN ACT TO RESTORE THE RIGHT OF SUFFRAGE TO JAY W. JACKSON OF HINDS COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI.

- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 4 **SECTION 1.** The right of suffrage is hereby fully and
- 5 completely restored to Jay W. Jackson of Hinds County,
- 6 Mississippi, who was disqualified as an elector as a result of his
- 7 conviction on September 9, 2011, in Rankin County for the crime of
- 8 robbery, and who was sentenced to serve in the Regimented Inmate
- 9 Program in the custody of the Department of Corrections. He
- 10 completed and was released from the Regimented Inmate Program on
- 11 May 10, 2012, to serve a five year probation term. He completed
- 12 his probation and was discharged on April 8, 2016. The
- 13 Legislature is informed that he has since conducted himself as a
- 14 law-abiding and honorable citizen in a good and lawful manner.
- 15 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 16 and after its passage.
