A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION COMMENDING THE ESTEEMED AND LAUDABLE

24 WHEREAS, upon his election in 1980, Tyrone Ellis became the 25 distinguished Gentleman from Oktibbeha and wasted no time requesting the legislation, amendments and reports that would help 26 27 effectuate into law the ideologies and policy changes that his 28 constituents had elected him to further, and because of his 29 passion and genuine desire to better this great Magnolia State, he 30 became the first member to serve as Majority Leader of the 31 Mississippi House of Representatives; and
