- 3 FOR WINNING THE 2017 MISSISSIPPI BANDMASTERS
- 4 ASSOCIATION/MISSISSIPPI HIGH SCHOOL ACTIVITIES ASSOCIATION (MHSAA)
- 5 CLASS 2A STATE MARCHING BAND CHAMPIONSHIP.
- 6 WHEREAS, for the first time ever in the school's history, the
- 7 Mize High School Pride Marching Band won the 2017 Mississippi
- 8 Bandmasters Association/Mississippi High School Activities
- 9 Association Class 2A State Marching Band Championship on Saturday,
- 10 November 4, 2017, accomplishing a feat that has been a coveted
- 11 prize for the student musicians; and
- 12 WHEREAS, scored on music, marching, visual and general
- 13 effects, the band competed against several well-contended bands
- 14 throughout the state in what proved to be a long day of events
- 15 after traveling to Pearl High School to embark upon the
- 16 performance of a lifetime; and
- 17 WHEREAS, the band program, led by fifth-year Mize Band
- 18 Director Patrick Vincent, with the assistance of his wife Emily,
- 19 who serves as color guard instructor and band assistant, stunned

- 20 the crowd and awed the judges at Pearl High School with a riveting
- 21 performance of "Starry Night," in tribute to Vincent Van Gogh's
- 22 creation of the famous painting bearing the performance's
- 23 namesake, arranged by Randall Standridge and drill design by
- 24 Robert Strunks; and
- 25 WHEREAS, deflecting the praise lauded upon himself and his
- 26 wife, the Vincents devoted countless hours preparing the band
- 27 members for the biggest show of talent and artistry of the year
- 28 after qualifying for marching competition upon receiving
- 29 All-Superior ratings during the MHSAA District Marching Festival
- 30 which qualified them for state championship competition in 2016
- 31 and 2017; and
- 32 WHEREAS, the Mississippi High School Activities Association
- 33 and the Mississippi Bandmasters Association began this series of
- 34 competitions 14 years ago, and this state title win by Mize, which
- 35 resulted in a first-place finish in music performance,
- 36 second-place finishes in visual performance and percussion and a
- 37 third-place finish in general effect, honors the band's rich
- 38 history in musical excellence, exemplified in the long hours, hard
- 39 work and attention to detail put into the show's precise
- 40 execution; and

- 48 Blackwell; tenor saxophone, Dawson Temple; baritone saxophone,
- 49 Christopher Bowen; trumpets, Garret Anglin, Bailey Kile, Byron

- 51 Davidson, Joanna Dickerson and Tanner Barnett; French horns, Zach

- 59 highest honor attainable within the two associations' honors and
- 60 awards, and have remained consistent in dedicating each of their
- 61 performances to the Lord; and
- 62 WHEREAS, it is the policy of this Legislature to recognize
- 63 the special accomplishments and attitude of such an outstanding
- 64 group of student musicians as the Mize High School Marching Band,
- 65 who have brought honor to their school, their parents, their
- 66 community and to the State of Mississippi:
