HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 70

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION COMMENDING THE MURRAH HIGH SCHOOL 2 MURRAH CONCERT SINGERS FOR THEIR OUTSTANDING CHORAL ACHIEVEMENTS 3 AND FOR BEING INVITED TO PARTICIPATE AT THE WORLDSTRIDES ONSTAGE 4 FESTIVAL CONCERT TOUR IN ITALY.

5 WHEREAS, the Murrah Concert Singers from Murrah High School 6 in Jackson, Mississippi, have been invited to participate in the 7 WorldStrides OnStage Festival Concert Tour in Italy, where they 8 will participate in four cities across the country, Florence, 9 Rome, Venice and Milan, during their Spring Break in March 2018; 10 and

WHEREAS, dating back to recordings from the 1950s and 1960s, 11 12 the Murrah Choral Department is known as one of the best choral 13 departments throughout the district, state and nation, and is 14 comprised of the Murrah Concert Singers, Murrah Madrigals, Girls Choir, Boys Choir, Sextet and Quartet, with all of these groups 15 having competed at the district, state and national levels, where 16 17 they have been perpetually rated from advanced to superior levels; 18 and

19 WHEREAS, because of their superior performances, the Murrah 20 Concert Singers have been invited to compete at festivals across the nation where they have received numerous honors and awards, 21 22 including a district superior rating in 2008, 2009 and 2010; a 23 state superior rating in 2009 and 2010; a superior rating for 24 Concert Singers at Festival Disney in Orlando, Florida, where they competed against almost 300 choral groups; and the highest average 25 for all choirs at a festival in New Orleans; and 26

27 WHEREAS, the Murrah Concert Singers were invited to attend The Heritage Festival of Gold for Honor Choirs in New York City at 28 St. Bartholomew's Cathedral, where they were privileged to work 29 30 with internationally acclaimed composers such as Dr. Andre' Thomas 31 and Dr. Jeffrey Redding; the choir also competed in Washington, 32 D.C., and at the Choral Festival at Spellman College in Atlanta, 33 Georgia, rising above over 100 choirs; they further received an invitation to Chicago, Illinois, where they recorded live, with 34 35 other honor choirs, a commissioned piece conducted by world renowned composer and conductor, Dr. Rene Clausen; and 36

37 WHEREAS, the choir competed at the River Land Choral Festival 38 in Pearl, Mississippi, where the choir and madrigals received all 39 superior ratings: Best in Class awards in all categories, Best 40 Overall Choir award and Highest Score Overall award, and then the 41 choir competed against 126 choirs in Atlanta, Georgia, at the 42 WorldStrides Heritage Choral Festival and won overall with Girls 43 Choir having the highest score of 98; and

No. 70 **~ OFFICIAL ~** 18/HR31/R2072 PAGE 2 (MCL\JAB) 44 WHEREAS, after the choir's win at the festival in Atlanta, 45 they were invited to Los Angeles, California, to compete at the 46 WorldStrides Encore Performance Festival of Gold where they 47 received all superior ratings and the Girls Choir received the 48 highest score of 98, and upon receiving this honor the choir was 49 invited to perform on the international level at the WorldStrides 50 International Concert Tour in four cities across Italy; and

51 WHEREAS, since 2008, the Murrah Concert Singers have been 52 under the leadership of the Director of Choral Activities, Mr. 53 Pierrdro Gallion, a graduate of Jim Hill High School who studied 54 music education with an emphasis on vocal performance at the 55 University of Southern Mississippi and who earned his degree from 56 Jackson State University, and with his inspiration and their 57 amazing talent, the singers continue to soar on wings of musical 58 excellence; and

59 WHEREAS, it is the policy of this Legislature to commend 60 remarkably gifted students, such as the Murrah Concert Singers, 61 whose tremendous talent and dedication brings honor to their 62 school, community and the State of Mississippi:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN, That we do hereby commend the Murrah Concert Singers for their outstanding choral achievements and for being invited to participate at the WorldStrides OnStage Festival Concert Tour in Italy, and wish them the best in all of their future endeavors.
