HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 76

A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION COMMENDING MR. NOAH BARBIERI FOR HIS

2	EXCEPTIONAL DEDICATION TO ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE AND FOR BEING NAMED BOTH A TRUMAN SCHOLAR AND A RHODES SCHOLAR.
4	WHEREAS, Noah Barbieri was named both a Truman Scholar and a
5	Rhodes Scholar, an incredible accomplishment for Mr. Barbieri and
6	a true testament to his tremendous dedication to academic
7	excellence; and
8	WHEREAS, originally from Belden, Mississippi, Mr. Barbieri
9	attended Tupelo Christian Preparatory School, and after graduation
10	he moved to Jackson to attend Millsaps College, where he is
11	currently a senior majoring in economics and philosophy with a
12	minor in mathematics, and he has an outstanding 4.0 GPA and is
13	ranked number 1 in his class of 165 students; and
14	WHEREAS, the Harry S. Truman Scholarship Foundation was
15	created by the United States Congress in 1975 with the mission of
16	selecting and supporting the next generation of public service
17	leaders, and candidates for this prestigious scholarship endure a

rigorous, multi-stage selection process, and in 2017 there were

- 19 768 candidates for the award who were nominated by 315 colleges
- 20 and universities, and 199 finalists were interviewed at one of the
- 21 16 regional selection panels; and
- 22 WHEREAS, with his tremendous dedication to public service and
- 23 his exceptional drive for academic excellence, Mr. Barbieri is
- 24 only the second student in Millsaps College history to receive the
- 25 Truman Scholarship, and in addition to receiving the scholarship,
- 26 the foundation honored Mr. Barbieri for his work as a classroom
- 27 assistant at Brown Elementary School and for his research on
- 28 inequality; and
- 29 WHEREAS, in addition to being named a Truman Scholar, Mr.
- 30 Barbieri is the second Millsaps student in the past three years
- 31 and the seventh student in the history of the college to be named
- 32 a Rhodes Scholar, which is considered one of the most prestigious
- 33 academic scholarships in the world; and
- 34 WHEREAS, the Rhodes Trust, an international charity
- 35 established in honor of British mining magnate and politician,
- 36 Cecil J. Rhodes, grants scholarships to approximately 95 students
- 37 worldwide, with 32 students from the United States and its
- 38 territories, and it provides full funding for graduate level
- 39 studies at the University of Oxford in the United Kingdom; and
- 40 WHEREAS, Mr. Barbieri has made the most of his time at
- 41 Millsaps College, serving as the Presidential Ambassador in the
- 42 Admissions Office and as a tutor in the Math Department, and he
- 43 has held several leadership positions, serving as the Student Body

- 44 Senator, Student Body Treasurer and Student Body Parliamentarian,
- 45 and he is currently serving as the Student Body President, and was
- 46 selected as Student Body Leader of the Year; and
- WHEREAS, during his exceptional undergraduate career, Mr.
- 48 Barbieri completed honors projects in both economics and
- 49 philosophy, and he has held various positions in several academic
- 50 honorary societies, such as president of the Omicron Delta Epsilon
- 51 economics honorary; former president of the Phi Eta Sigma freshman
- 52 honorary; and past treasurer of the Sigma Lambda service honorary,
- 53 and he is a member of the Omicron Delta Kappa leadership honorary;
- 54 the Eta Sigma Phi classics honorary; and the Pi Mu Epsilon
- 55 mathematics honorary; and
- 56 WHEREAS, in addition to his tremendous involvement on campus,
- 57 Mr. Barbieri has a passion for helping those who need it most, and
- 58 one of his most meaningful experiences was his time at Brown
- 59 Elementary School as a classroom assistant during his freshman
- 60 year of college, where he tutored students in reading and in math,
- 61 and it was there that he began to realize numerous problems that
- 62 the state is facing each day, and how, because of those problems,
- 63 many people suffer in different ways across the state, and it was
- 64 then that he decided to use his unique skills to make a difference
- 65 in Mississippi; and
- WHEREAS, Mr. Barbieri is scheduled to graduate from Millsaps
- 67 College in May 2018 and he plans to use his extraordinary
- 68 scholarships to pursue a master's degree in economics at the

- 69 University of Oxford in the United Kingdom, after which he intends
- 70 to pursue a doctorate degree in economics from the Massachusetts
- 71 Institute of Technology in Cambridge, Massachusetts; and
- 72 WHEREAS, with his passion for helping Mississippi become the
- 73 best it can be for all of its citizens, Mr. Barbieri intends to
- 74 use his knowledge and skills to run for political office, and he
- 75 further intends to help formulate practical, holistic solutions to
- 76 issues that the state faces each day; and
- 77 WHEREAS, Mr. Barbieri possesses the unique qualities that
- 78 both President Truman and Cecil J. Rhodes envisioned for the
- 79 recipients of their respective scholarships, and he will join the
- 80 ranks of prominent individuals who are both a Rhodes Scholar and a
- 81 Truman Scholar, such as Susan E. Rice, the 24th National Security
- 82 Advisor, United States Ambassador to the United Nations and former
- 83 Assistant Secretary of State, and George Stephanopoulos, a former
- 84 political advisor to President Bill Clinton and an ABC News
- 85 anchor; and
- WHEREAS, the President of Millsaps College, Dr. Robert W.
- 87 Pearigen, stated that Mr. Barbieri embodies the best of a liberal
- 88 arts education, and by extension, the virtues for which Rhodes
- 89 Scholars are known, and he has employed each of his three
- 90 undergraduate majors, which span the three divisions of Millsaps
- 91 College, to better understand and address practical challenges
- 92 facing his native state of Mississippi; and

93	WHEREAS, Kenneth Townsend, the executive director of the
94	Millsaps Institute for Civic and Professional Engagement, stated
95	that Mr. Barbieri's persistence in the pursuit of excellence is
96	truly extraordinary, and part of the reason he has excelled in
97	every facet of his life is that he simply works harder than just
98	about any undergraduate that Mr. Townsend has ever encountered;

100	WHEREAS, it is the policy of this Legislature to recognize
101	outstanding Mississippians, especially those such as Noah
102	Barbieri, whose exceptional dedication to academic excellence and
103	whose devotion to the betterment of the Magnolia State and its
104	citizens bring honor to his school, his community and to the State
105	of Mississippi:
106	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF
107	REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI, THE SENATE CONCURRING
108	THEREIN, That we do hereby commend Mr. Noah Barbieri for his
109	exceptional dedication to academic excellence and for being named
110	both a Truman Scholar and a Rhodes Scholar, and extend to him
111	sincere wishes for his continued success in his future endeavors.
