## HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 85

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF 2 THE MISSISSIPPI GAMING COMMISSION, THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE 3 JOINT LEGISLATIVE COMMITTEE ON PERFORMANCE EVALUATION AND 4 EXPENDITURE REVIEW, THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE MISSISSIPPI 5 DEPARTMENT OF MARINE RESOURCES, AND THE SECRETARY OF STATE TO 6 DEVELOP A MAP INDICATING THE GEOGRAPHIC AREA ON THE MISSISSIPPI 7 COAST THAT IS ELIGIBLE FOR LICENSED GAMING UNDER STATE LAW. 8 WHEREAS, determining if a potential licensed gaming location 9 on the Mississippi Coast is within the geographic area allowed 10 under state law currently requires an individual determination 11 upon each request made to the Mississippi Gaming Commission; and 12 WHEREAS, efficiency and transparency would be improved if a map existed to determine eligibility of a proposed licensed gaming 13 14 location on the Mississippi Coast; and 15 WHEREAS, the Executive Director of the Mississippi Gaming 16 Commission, the Executive Director of the Joint Legislative 17 Committee on Performance Evaluation and Expenditure Review, the 18 Executive Director of the Mississippi Department of Marine Resources, and the Secretary of State are best equipped at 19 developing a map that will provide clarity and efficiency in 20

21 determining if a potential licensed gaming location on the 22 Mississippi Coast is within the geographic area eligible under 23 state law; and

24 WHEREAS, it is the policy of this Legislature to favor 25 efficiency and transparency:

26 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF 27 REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI, THE SENATE CONCURRING 28 THEREIN, That we do hereby request the Executive Director of the 29 Mississippi Gaming Commission, the Executive Director of the Joint 30 Legislative Committee on Performance Evaluation and Expenditure 31 Review, the Executive Director of the Mississippi Department of 32 Marine Resources, and the Secretary of State to develop a map 33 indicating the geographic area on the Mississippi Coast that is eligible for licensed gaming under state law. 34

35 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That copies of this resolution be 36 furnished to the Executive Director of the Mississippi Gaming 37 Commission, the Executive Director of the Joint Legislative 38 Committee on Performance Evaluation and Expenditure Review, the 39 Executive Director of the Mississippi Department of Marine 40 Resources, the Secretary of State and to the members of the 41 Capitol Press Corps.
