HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 20

1 A RESOLUTION COMMENDING AND CONGRATULATING TYLER PEARSON FOR 2 CAPTURING THE TITLE OF WORLD CHAMPION STEER WRESTLER AT THE 2017 3 WRANGLER NATIONAL FINALS RODEO IN LAS VEGAS, NEVADA. 4 WHEREAS, Tyler Pearson, originally from Louisville, Mississippi, received national recognition and worldwide fame when 5 he became the World Champion Steer Wrestler at the 2017 Wrangler 6 7 National Finals Rodeo in Las Vegas, Nevada; and WHEREAS, the son of Larry and Cheryl Pearson and the grandson 8 9 of Charlene Price and the late Thomas Price and the late Willis and Pauline Pearson, Tyler realized his natural ability for riding 10 11 horses at the age of eight, and he began team roping and roped in jackpots until he started competing in the Mississippi Junior High 12 13 School Rodeos when he was in the fifth grade; and

14 WHEREAS, during his formative years, Tyler competed in calf 15 roping, team roping, cutting and eventually steer wrestling, 16 winning All Around Awards at many rodeos and year end awards, and 17 he qualified for the High School Nationals all four years of high 18 school thanks in large part to his love for the sport and athletic
19 prowess; and

20 WHEREAS, Tyler attended college at the University of West 21 Alabama in Livingston, Alabama, where he competed on the rodeo 22 team and qualified for the College National Finals, placing fourth 23 in steer wrestling; and

24 WHEREAS, after college, Tyler devoted his time and energy to 25 the Professional Rodeo Cowboy Association (PRCA), striving every 26 day to achieve his dreams and make it to the "Big Show," the 27 "Superbowl of Rodeos," the National Finals Rodeo in Las Vegas, 28 Nevada, and in 2013, that dream became a reality, as he qualified 29 in the top 15 in the world; and

WHEREAS, a couple of days before competition began at the National Finals Rodeo, Tyler heard a pop, it came from his knee, but he was determined to compete and remained resolute that he was not going to let his knee keep him from the ropes and the reins, so he strapped on a locked brace and proceeded to throw every single steer in his 10 rounds of competition, ultimately placing fourth in the average; and

37 WHEREAS, after the rodeo was over, Tyler had knee surgery but 38 was soon back to the bulls and the blood, the dust and the mud, 39 and his next qualification came in 2017, as he was ranked second 40 in the world going into the National Finals Rodeo competition; and 41 WHEREAS, during the 2017 National Finals Rodeo, Tyler had the 42 best rodeos of his career, throwing his steer in all 10 rounds of

43 competition to win second in average and capture the coveted title 44 of World Champion Steer Wrestler, a truly great honor that 45 culminated a lifetime of diligence and devotion spent chasing the 46 dream they call rodeo; and

47 WHEREAS, Tyler clinched the revered gold buckle with the help 48 of his swift, muscular, faithful horse, Scooter, who was named the 49 2017 Horse of the Year; and

50 WHEREAS, additionally, Tyler has won the Wrangler Champions 51 Challenge presented by Justin Boots, the Lawton Rangers Rodeo, the 52 La Fiesta De Los Vaqueros, the Silver State Stampede, the Hugo 53 PRCA Rodeo, the Johnson County Sheriff's Posse, the Rose City 54 Roundup, and was named co-champion at the Avi River Stampede PRCA 55 Rodeo; and

56 WHEREAS, his many successes, the joy and the pain would not have been possible without the unwavering support of his wife and 57 58 biggest supporter, Carissa Purvis Pearson; children, Stetson and 59 Steelie; parents, Larry and Cheryl Pearson; other relatives and friends; the wonderful people of his hometown, Louisville; and his 60 61 sponsors, 12 Gauge Ranch, CINCH JEANS, Resistol Hats, Purina, 62 Classic Equine, Hanna Equine Veterinary Services LLC, and RCI 63 Industries; and

64 WHEREAS, it is the policy of the House of Representatives to 65 recognize and commend fine Mississippians, especially those such 66 as Tyler Pearson, a young man with an unparalleled amount of 67 determination that set goals for himself and strives daily to
