1 A RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING AND HONORING MS. OLIVIA KNIGHT FOR

2 BEING CROWNED AS MISS JR. TEEN MISSISSIPPI 2017 AND FOR HER

3 TREMENDOUS DEDICATION TO COMMUNITY SERVICE.

4 WHEREAS, Ms. Olivia Knight of Corinth, Mississippi, a

5 sixteen-year-old sophomore at Corinth High School, was recently

6 crowned as Miss Jr. Teen Mississippi 2017; and

WHEREAS, after competing in the pageant and winning the

8 fitness division, Olivia finished as runner-up to Ms. Alanha

9 Dukes, who went on to win the national title of Miss Jr. Teen

10 United States, which caused the title of Miss Jr. Teen Mississippi

11 to pass to Olivia; and

12 WHEREAS, devoted to serving her community, Olivia has amassed

13 over 350 hours in community service, and the time she has invested

14 serving her community and promoting causes that she believes in is

15 truly remarkable, and the issue that is the closest to her heart

16 is the widespread bullying crisis that Mississippi currently is

17 facing among young people; and

18	WHEREAS, Olivia chose the platform of "S.T.O.P. Bullying" to
19	bring awareness to this crisis in Mississippi, because throughout
20	kindergarten, first and second grade, she had a first-hand
21	experience with both physical and verbal bullying, and she has
22	promoted her platform by speaking to over 370 elementary and
23	middle school children across the state, speaking at the Family
24	Research Council Bullying Awareness Kickoff and being interviewed
25	for television about her experience with bullying; and
26	WHEREAS, tragically, this widespread bullying crisis has been
27	linked to Mississippi's suicide rate being the second leading
28	cause of death of young people between the ages of 10 and 24, and
29	it is Olivia's goal to have legislation passed in Mississippi that
30	contains consequences for the bully if the victim self-harms or
31	commits suicide as a result of consistent or severe acts of
32	bullying; and
33	WHEREAS, in addition to her focus on bullying awareness,
34	Olivia has partnered with the ladies of the Junior Auxiliary of
35	Corinth to create the Corinth Crown Club, a service organization
36	for high school girls in Alcorn County which currently has 14
37	charter members, with each high school in the area being
38	represented, and this spring she will complete her Girl Scout Gold
39	Award, the highest award that may be earned in the Girl Scouts;

41	WHEREAS, Olivia is also a youth board member for the Tobacco

Free Coalition for Alcorn and Tippah Counties and has helped with

- 43 several community service events for the coalition, and she also
- 44 serves on the Mayor's Youth Council, and in addition to her
- 45 community service, Olivia is dedicated to excelling in her
- 46 education, with a GPA of 100.35; and
- WHEREAS, it is the policy of the House of Representatives to
- 48 recognize and honor great Mississippians such as Ms. Olivia
- 49 Knight, a young woman who exudes poise, class and a tender heart,
- 50 and who serves as an asset and wonderful role model to young
- 51 people throughout the great Magnolia State and the nation:
